STRIKING CONVERTED VICTORIAN SCHOOL

This striking Grade II Listed property was built in 1845 and opened as a school in 1846. After closing in 1991 the property was converted for residential use becoming the home that it is today. Displaying many features from high ceilings to exposed beams and fireplaces to ornate windows, this unique family home occupies a prominent position in the sought-after village of Kilndown.

The accommodation consists of a triple aspect sitting room with log burning stove, wood panelling and exposed floorboards, a double aspect dining room with fireplace, wood panelling and exposed floorboards, a conservatory, a double aspect kitchen with Aga and door to the outside, a utility room with door to outside and a shower room on the ground floor.

On the first floor the triple aspect principal bedroom is vaulted with exposed beams and a double aspect bathroom, there are three additional double bedrooms and a family bathroom.

A gate in the stone wall leads across the mature garden to the front door. The enclosed garden to the rear is laid to lawn with a paved terrace and established planting. The driveway and garage are approached via Rogers Rough Road, a gate opens from the parking onto a path across the garden.





KILNDOWN

The village of Kilndown is located just outside the popular village of Goudhurst with its variety of village shops. Kilndown boasts a local public house renowned for its food, a pretty Church, the Quarry Centre and a Village Hall which offers Adult Education Classes.

SCHOOLS AND CONNECTIONS


