Bloxham Vale benefits from an excellent range of local amenities and rural pursuits, with the town of Banbury providing opportunities for shopping and dining, together with historic links and beautiful green spaces.







Just under two miles away is Banbury, an attractive town that provides the perfect balance of a busy town atmosphere and traditional village community. Throughout its charming streets you'll immediately discover a great range of amenities, independent and chain shops, and delightful restaurants and cafés, with cuisines including Thai, Chinese and Italian. Several weekly markets are also held in the town centre offering fresh produce, and arts and crafts.

Castle Quay Shopping Centre headlines Banbury's retail offering, with its range of high street names across fashion, technology, and health and beauty. Banbury Gateway Shopping Park lies on the north east end of the town, with a further range of high-street stores that include Next, River Island and Mountain Warehouse. Shopping on a grander scale can be enjoyed at Bicester Village just a 30-minute drive away, with an incredible range of luxury brands on offer including Calvin Klein, Dior, Diesel, Karen Millen and Mulberry. Banbury and its surrounding areas are full of interesting history that's just waiting to be discovered.

Enjoy a quiet drink or hearty meal at Ye Olde Reindeer Inn, a delightful traditional pub where it's believed Oliver Cromwell once hatched important battle plans during the English Civil War. Just a 5-minute drive away on the outskirts of Banbury is Broughton Castle, an imposing 14th-century manor house with a rich history of war and royalty. Further history can be discovered in Edgehill just 15 minutes away by car, including the magnificent country mansion at Upton House and Gardens. Lord Bearsted's private art collection, a former resident of the home, is still on display against the picturesque and peaceful backdrop of its surrounding gardens.

Just a 20-minute drive away is the village of Hook Norton, home of the Hook Norton Brewery. Dating back to 1849, the brewery's plant is a perfect example of a Victorian Tower Brewery, offering award winning beers and tours, as well as a gift shop and restaurant.





A LIFE WELL CONNECTED

Bloxham Vale is just a 5-minute drive from Banbury Station, providing links to Oxford in 18 minutes, Reading in 44 minutes, Birmingham New Street in 47 minutes and London Marylebone in an hour. The development also benefits from an excellent road network that provides journeys to both Royal Leamington Spa and Bicester in around 35 minutes, whilst both Milton Keynes and Aylesbury are reachable in just under an hour. Junction 10 of M40 can be joined in around 10 minutes for journeys to both Birmingham and London.

Birmingham International Airport is just under an hour away by car, which provides flights to a number of exciting destinations, including Dublin, Edinburgh, Belfast, Paris and Barcelona.

A PLATFORM TO LEARN & GROW








Bloxham Vale is surrounded by a range of well-regarded schools, from nursery all the way up to university. Children can begin their education at Rainbow Village Nursery or Bloxham pre-schools, before moving on to Bishop Loveday CofE, The Grange or St John's primary schools. Independent secondary options include Tudor Hall for girls as well as the co-educational Bloxham School. Further education is available at Banbury & Bicester College, which specialises in IT, creative arts, and vehicle and motorsports engineering. Bloxham Vale is also ideally placed for higher education, with Oxford's renowned university and its extended network of colleges approximately 45 minutes away by car.
