SITUATION

The property is conveniently situated a short walk from Hungerford High Street and railway station. Hungerford offers a range of local shops including butchers, bakers, post office, newsagent, chemist, and supermarket. The town is renowned as a centre for antiques. There is a primary school and secondary schooling. The mainline railway station has trains to London (Paddington) with Crossrail links from Reading station. Junction 14 of the M4 is some three miles north of the town.

heating and double glazing. Outside the property there is driveway parking for two cars, side access to the rear garden with patio and lawn.


The property is being sold with no onward chain and viewing is strongly recommended.
