Situation

Enjoying a delightful rural location boasting a far reaching countryside aspect, yet very conveniently set within some three miles or so of the small market town of Whitland which lies just off the A40 within the heart of the West Carmarthenshire Countryside. The town of Whitland has the benefit of a good range of local services and facilities that cater for everyday requirements. Carmarthen town is the principle administrative centre for the county and provides a wide array of commercial, educational and recreational facilities and lies some 15 miles distant from the plot of land.

Directions

From the direction of Narberth, proceed along the A40, bypassing the town of Whitland and when you approach the roundabout at the top of the town (Roadhouse Restaurant) take the first exit signposted Llanboidy. Continue on this road for some 2 miles and the entrance to the plot of land will be seen on the right hand side as denoted by our 'for sale' board. If you have reached the farm entrance of Penglogue on the right hand side, you have gone too far. Please see attached plan.

Description

A plot of land that extends to some 0.123 acres or thereabouts benefitting from excellent roadside access and identified as field number 2207 on the attached plan. A level plot of land which also includes a ruin of a former cottage.


