SITUATION

This parcel of land occupies a delightful rural setting in the tranquil countryside that lies on the periphery of the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park between the unspoilt villages of Martletwy and Llandshipping on the eastern shoreline of the tidal waters of the River Cleddau.

The area lies within easy reach of all the major towns of South Pembrokeshire, with the coastal resorts of Tenby and Saundersfoot being within a 20 minute drive. Local services can be found in the small town of Narberth which has in recent years become firmly established as one of the more sought after residential locations within the county having a range of shops and services.

Land in this area is renowned as being early productive land suitable for grazing and cropping with perhaps the potential for some alternative use, subject to the necessary consents being obtained.

DESCRIPTION

A plan of the land is attached for identification purposes only.

Castle Meadow comprises one level enclosure extending to 8.5 acres or thereabouts having the benefit of roadside access off the minor road that links Martletwy to the riverside village of Llandshipping. The land is level and is down to pasture with well established natural hedgebanks that provide a degree of natural shelter.

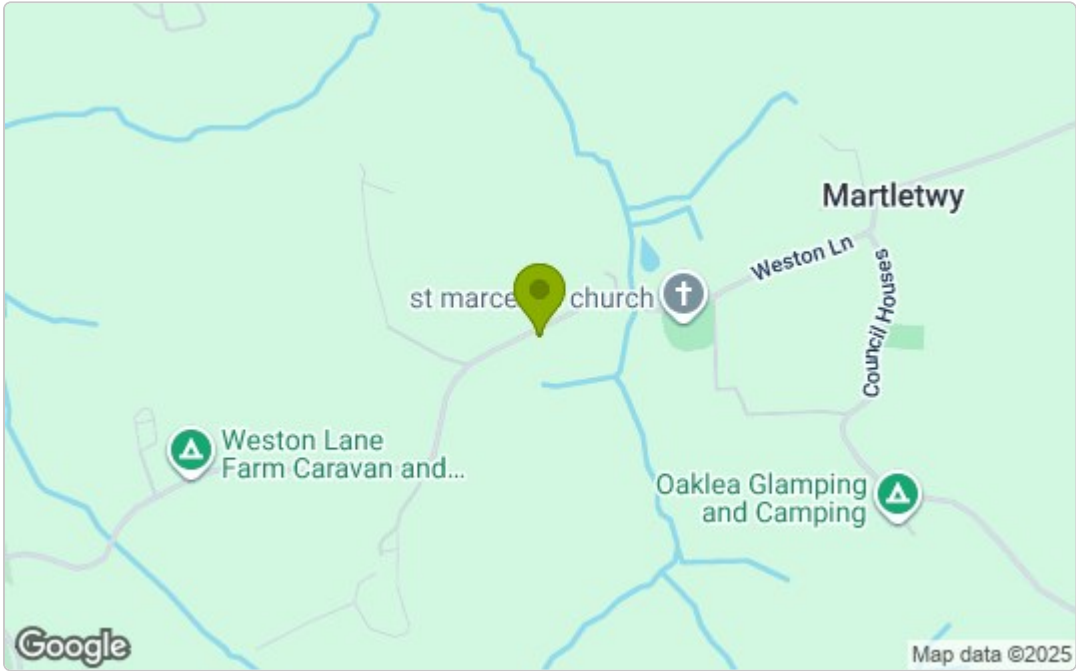

GENERAL REMARKS

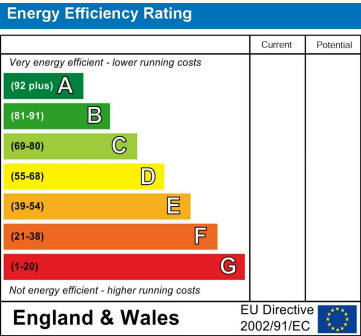
