Originally gifted by Susanna De Hoghton, heiress of Astley Hall this wonderful home is full of character and has been in the same family for four generations. To the front the crushed slate driveway can accommodate several vehicles and leads past the lawn to the main entrance. Step into reception one with gas stove in hearth and exposed beams, and from there to the equally spacious second reception room with original flagged flooring and multifuel stove in imposing hearth. The dining kitchen is to the rear and comprises a range of wall and base units with free standing appliances and Ideal central heating boiler. Completing the ground floor are the utility room with space, power & plumbing for additional appliances, and the shower room comprising electric shower in cubicle, wash hand basin, wc and ladder heated towel rail. Step outside into the long rear garden with lawn bordered by mature planting where you can entertain or just relax and take in the views. Back inside, stairs lead up to the good sized first floor landing which could be used as a reading area or home office with views over open countryside. Both bedrooms are great sized doubles, each with the original hearth in situ, and the elegant bathroom comprises fully tiled elevations and flooring, I shaped bath and screen with rainfall mixer shower over, wc, wash hand basin on vanity and ladder heated towel rail. A property of provenance with 1100 square feet of accommodation and beautiful views just waiting for you to make it your perfect home.


