To the front, a driveway for three vehicles leads to the garage, complete with power, lighting and additional storage. The main entrance opens into a welcoming hallway and through to the heart of the home, where a spacious dining and family area provides plenty of room for entertaining and relaxation, with patio doors opening onto the garden. The kitchen offers a range of wall and base units, a gas hob, Bosch multi oven, electric oven and grill, and dishwasher. From here, you step into the older part of the property, where the spacious living room showcases exposed beams and an inset remote-controlled living flame gas fire, blending period character with modern comfort. The east wing includes a large double bedroom with garden views, a comfortable single bedroom, and a bathroom with electric shower, wc, and floating wash hand basin. A separate laundry room with power, plumbing, and space for appliances offers potential to create a self-contained annex, ideal for multigenerational living or quest accommodation. Outside, the delightful gardens feature a lawn, charming cottage-style planting, redwood decking, and far-reaching countryside views. There's also a gardener's wc and large storage shed for convenience. Upstairs, the first floor landing includes a cosy reading area, along with two double bedrooms, one benefiting from built-in wardrobes. The family bathroom comprises a bath with shower attachment, wc, wash hand basin, ladder-style heated towel rail, and useful storage. Further features include solar panels with feed-in tariff, and an American-style integrated vacuum system.
