Deep windowsills of solid stone speak of the solidity of the build, while an exposed brick wall adds warmth and character. A summerhouse and versatile garage, currently partially transformed into a home gym, highlights the versatility of Elm Barn.



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



Morton offers several shops and a post office along with beautiful 14th century church, pub and restaurant. To get out and about, there are bus services that stretch from Lincoln to Peterborough. For families, there is a primary school in the village and Elm Barn also has the advantage of being in the catchment area for Bourne Grammar School with Stamford and Witham-on-the-Hill independent schools also close by. The historic market town of Bourne offers a range of supermarkets, shops, bars, restaurants, health services and a leisure centre. Green spaces perfect for dog walks and bike rides, churches, an abbey and a museum provide a backdrop of culture and peace within this vibrant town.

Bourne is close to the Georgian market town of Stamford and the city of Peterborough, which has direct train links to London King's Cross making the commute or a day trip to London very straightforward.
