




14 New Street

Dating back to the 16th Century, 14 New Street is a 1 bedroom, Grade II Listed cottage in the heart of Henley-on-Thames. Originally part of a larger house, Barnaby Cottages were originally built in 1582, were divided into 5 separate dwellings in 1788 and were, until recently, Alms Houses in the town. The property retains original features including exposed timbers and comprises a sitting room, kitchen, inner courtyard, downstairs bathroom and an upstairs bedroom with dressing/study area.

To the rear of the property is an outdoor store and communal garden with side access.

The property now requires updating, but would make an ideal pied á terre or investment opportunity.

Situation

New Street is an elegant street of period properties and designated a Conservation Area in the favoured north side of Henley-on-Thames. At one end of New Street is the central shopping area of the town, and, at the other, the iconic River Thames. Moments away are the Phyllis Court Club, Hotel Du Vin and The Kenton Theatre.

Henley-on-Thames is an attractive market town situated in beautiful and unspoilt countryside, approximately 36 miles west of Central London. Henley offers a wide range of excellent shopping, prize winning restaurants as well as a 3 screen cinema and theatre. The town is world famous for the annual Henley Royal Regatta and hosts the Henley Festival of Music & Arts, Henley Literary Festival and regional farmers markets. The prestigious Leander Club, well supported Rugby Club and Phyllis Court (a private members club), are all within walking distance. There are numerous primary and secondary schools as well as Henley sixth form college.
