This beautiful 16<sup>th</sup> century cottage offers deceptively spacious accommodation with a wealth of character, large secluded garden and garaging for two vehicles.



### **The Property**

This beautiful Grade II listed cottage is situated within a short walk of Wendover High Street and within easy reach of the mainline station. The property is understood to date back to the 16<sup>th</sup> Century and has been updated to a very high standard in recent years by the current owner. The run of cottages were believed to be gifted to Anne Boleyn by Henry VIII as a wedding present, hence why they are known locally as Anne Boleyn Cottages. The well-presented accommodation is both spacious and versatile and offers a wealth of character with latch and brace door furniture, exposed beams and open fireplaces, under a thatched roof. #### **Outside**

The good sized rear garden enjoys a high degree of seclusion and is a real feature of the property having been attractively landscaped. There is a large paved patio immediately abutting the property with a pathway leading onto a lawned area and well stocked flower and herbaceous beds and borders. There is an attractive beech hedge, behind which is a further area of 'natural' garden with two timber sheds, mature trees and a gated access to the garaging/parking area.

#### Location


Wendover is a most attractive thriving village set at the foot of the Chiltern hills just to the south east of the county town of Aylesbury. Road access to London could either be via the A413 and M40 or the A41 and M1. The village has a railway station, at the top of the high street on the Chilterns railway line providing commuter services to Marylebone in 45-50 minutes. It also offers good day to day shopping facilities and has a regular weekly market on



Thursdays, Health Centre, Dentists, Library. There are schools in the village for all ages and the renowned grammar school and high schools are in Aylesbury together with the Sir Henry Floyd co-ed Grammar school. There are many opportunities for recreation close to the village including Wendover Woods and Coombe Hill and most sports are available in the Aylesbury Vale.








