There are no water or electricity connections on the land but we are advised they are available close by.

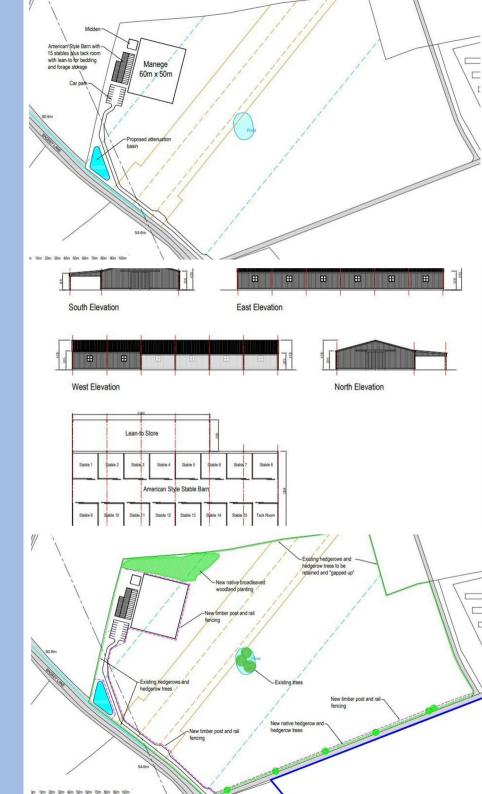

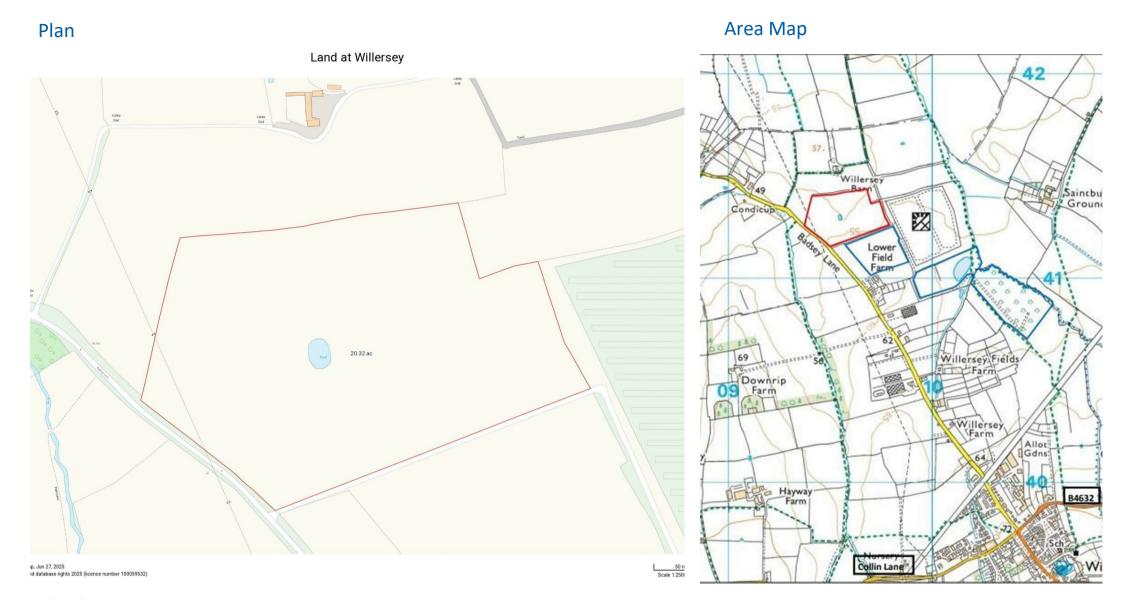
