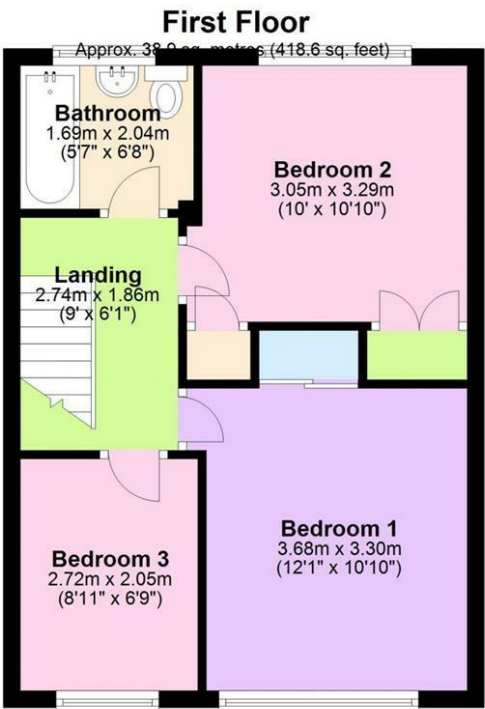
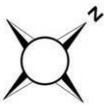
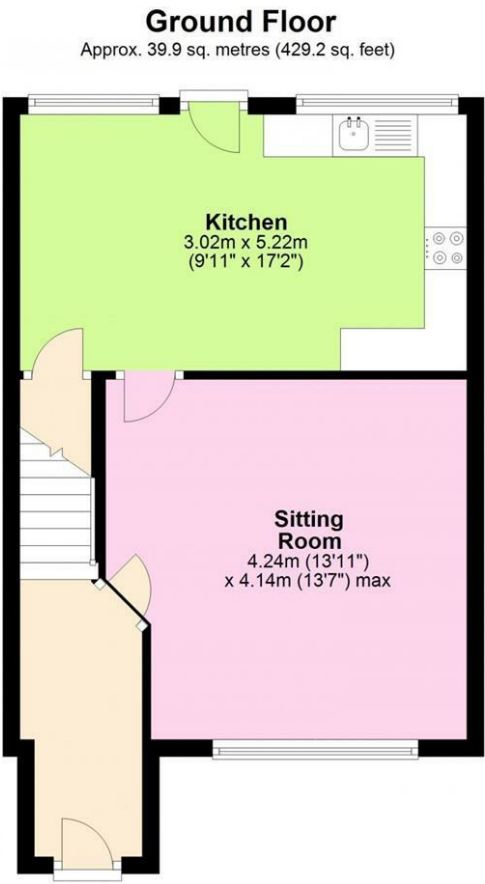
Step outside to a sunny, low-maintenance rear garden, fully enclosed and featuring a large decked area—ideal for summer BBQs and relaxed outdoor living.

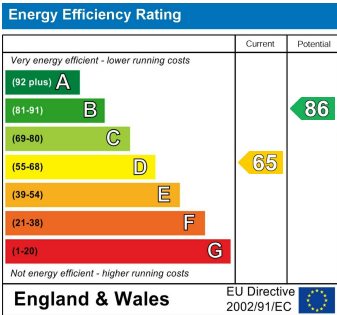
