

The Street, South Stoke, Reading, RG8 OJS

An impressive detached character barn, rebuilt in 1993 to replicate the original farm building, constructed in traditional brick and stained boarding beneath a pitched clay tiled roof. Centrally positioned in a classic English riverside village, the property offers convenient access to the River Thames at both ends of the village, along with a community store, pub, primary school, and is just 2.2 miles from Goring-on-Thames mainline station, providing direct access to London in under an hour.

Accommodation includes: a spacious vaulted entrance hall, a 23ft open-plan kitchen/dining room, utility room, cloakroom, 19ft drawing room with log burner, sitting room, ground floor bedroom with en-suite shower room. The first floor features a large galleried landing with study area, principal bedroom with eaves storage and en-suite bathroom (including claw and ball bath and separate shower), two further bedrooms with interconnecting bathroom, and a study/bedroom four.

Externally the property boasts two private south-westerly facing courtyards, parking and storage.


