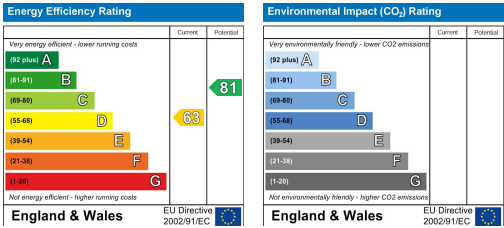
Area Map
