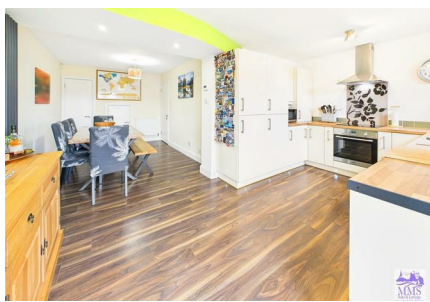

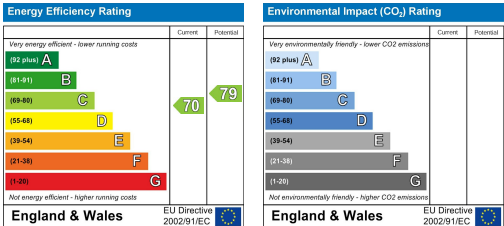
Area Map
