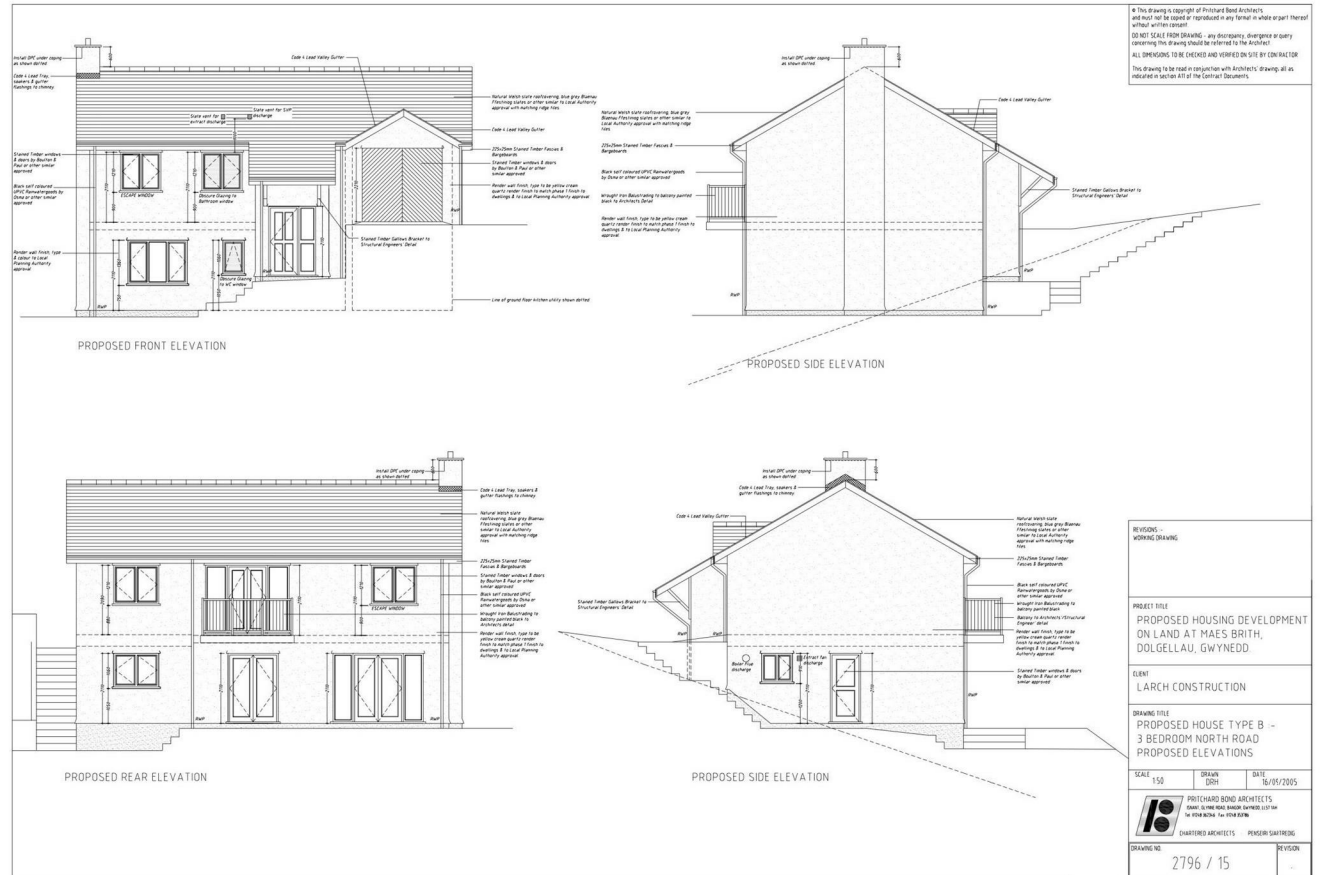

Access for vehicles and plant is excellent and the plot is situated in an elevated position with glorious open views across the town and the surrounding hills and countryside. The development is a 10 minute walk from the bustling town centre.

The properties will all be freehold.

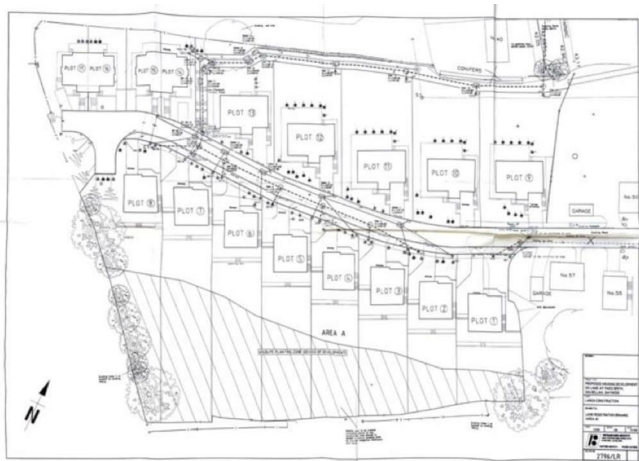

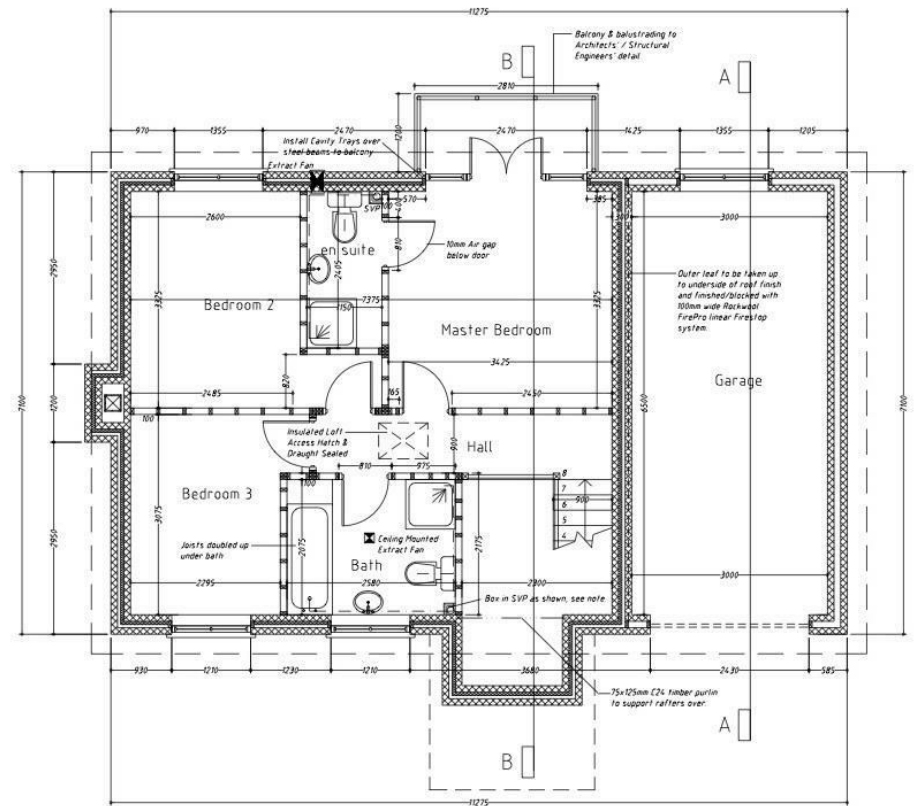
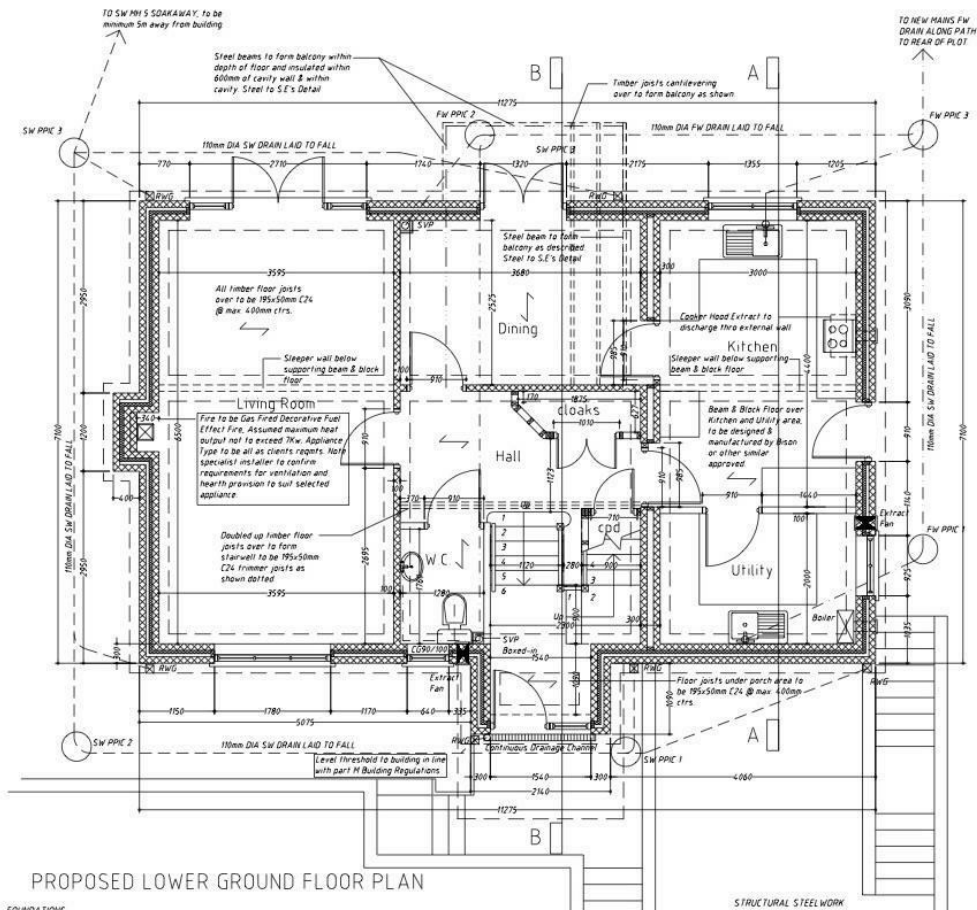
