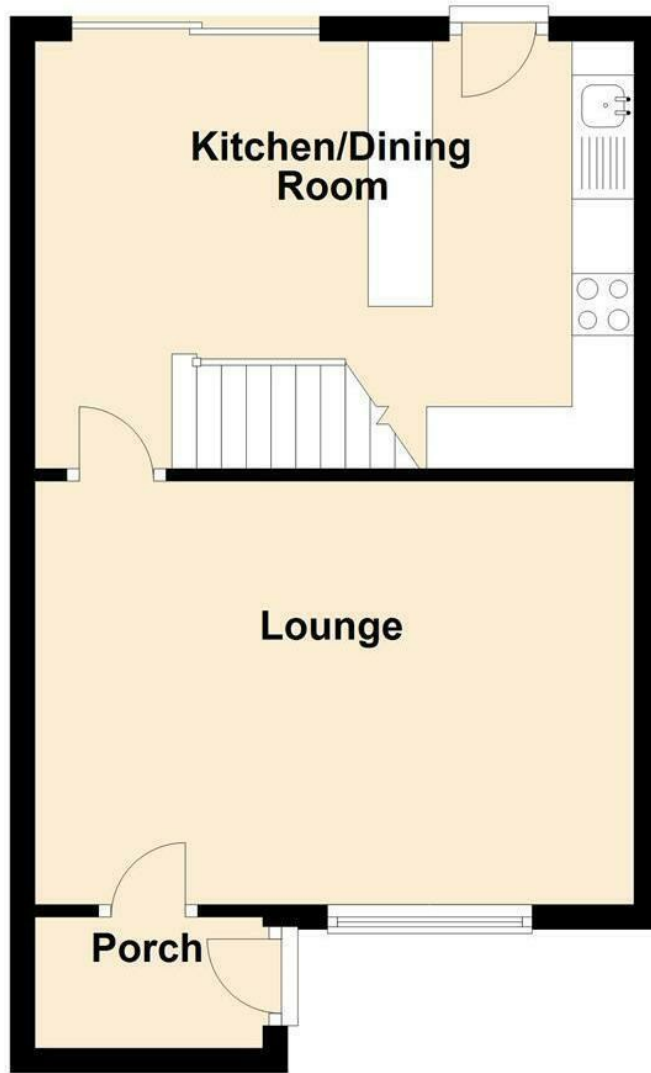

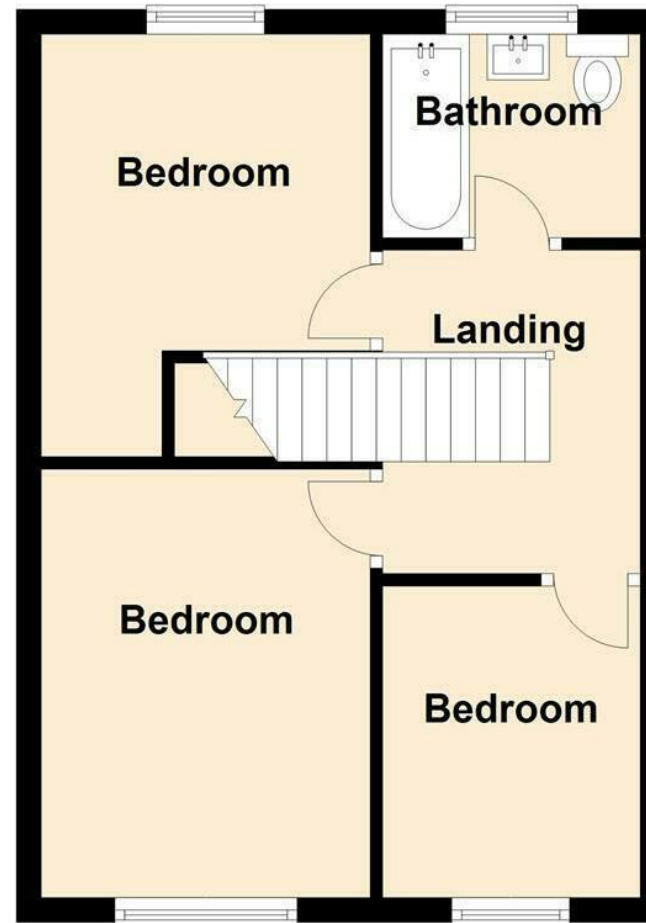
Ground Floor
