ENTRANCE HALLWAY

External door to hallway, ceiling light point, wall mounted radiator, internal doors to the ground floor accommodation.

BEDROOM ONE

12' 7" \times 7' 5" (3.84m \times 2.26m) Located at the rear of the property, this double bedroom overlooks the garden and is filled with natural light. with wall-mounted radiator and ceiling light.

BEDROOM TWO

7' 6" x 7' 0" (2.29m x 2.13m) uPVC double glazed window to the front elevation, wall-mounted radiator and ceiling light.

BEDROOM THREE

8' 4" x 7' 5" (2.54m x 2.26m) Featuring uPVC double glazed sliding patio doors that provide direct access to the garden, this bright and airy bedroom is ideal for enjoying indooroutdoor living. Wall-mounted radiator and ceiling light point.

BATHROOM

6' 7" x 5' 0" (2.01m x 1.52m) A modern three-piece suite comprises a low-level WC, pedestal sink with storage underneath, and a shower unit. Floor-to-ceiling tiling, ceiling light point, and a chrome wall-mounted towel radiator.

LOUNGE/DINER

16' 8" x 12' 4" (5.08m x 3.76m) Stairs from the ground to the first floor offers access into a bright and airy lounge/dining room with large uPVC double glazed windows to both the rear and front elevations. Rear windows provide a lovely garden aspect, while front windows offer far-reaching countryside views. Two wall-mounted radiators and ceiling light points.

KITCHEN

8' 4" x 7' 0" (2.54m x 2.13m) A spacious kitchen fitted with a mix of high and low-level units, complemented by contrasting work surfaces and a stylish tiled splashback. It features a four ring gas hob with extractor fan, electric oven, and a stainless steel sink with mixer tap and drainer. 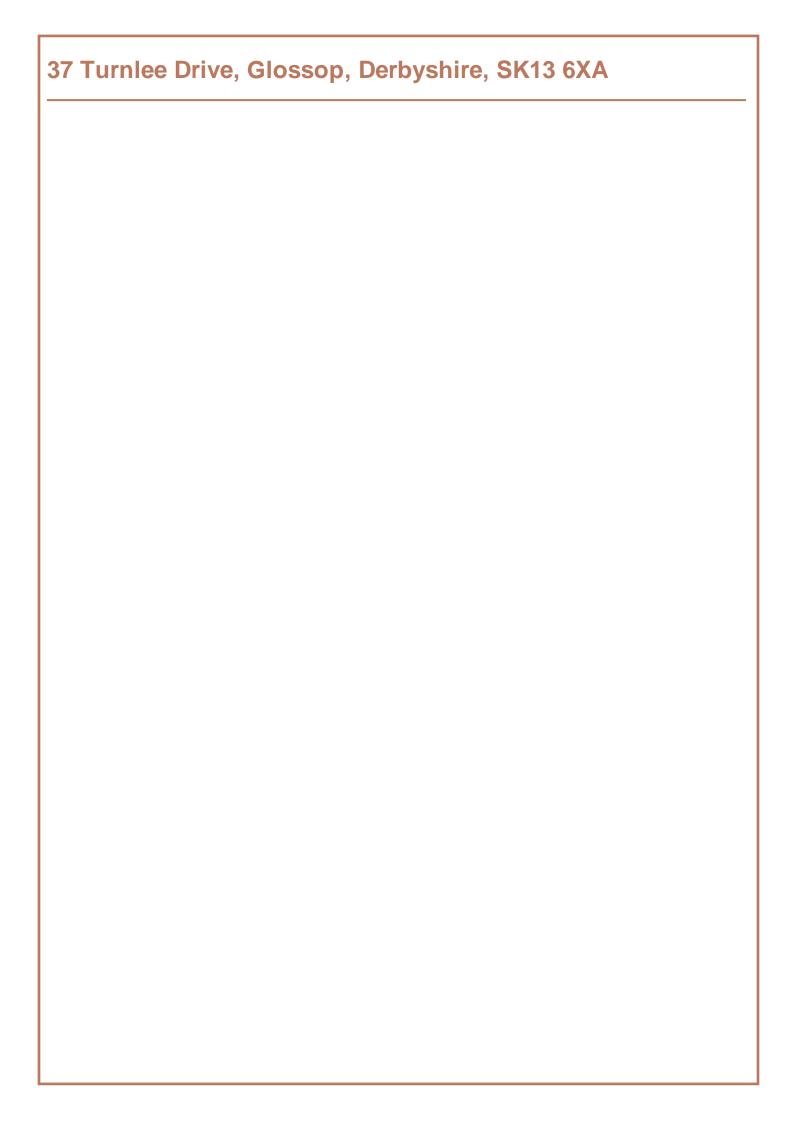




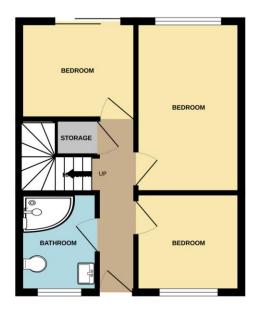


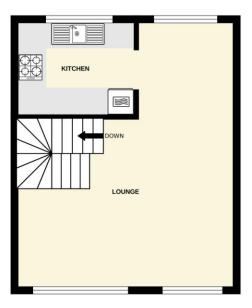






GROUND FLOOR 1ST FLOOR
