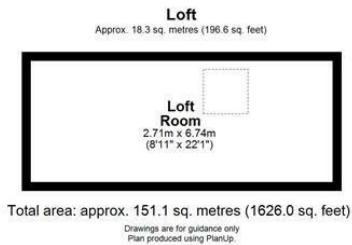
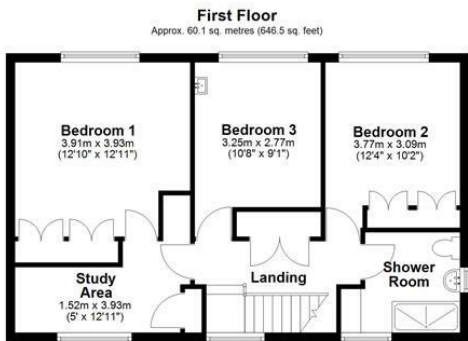
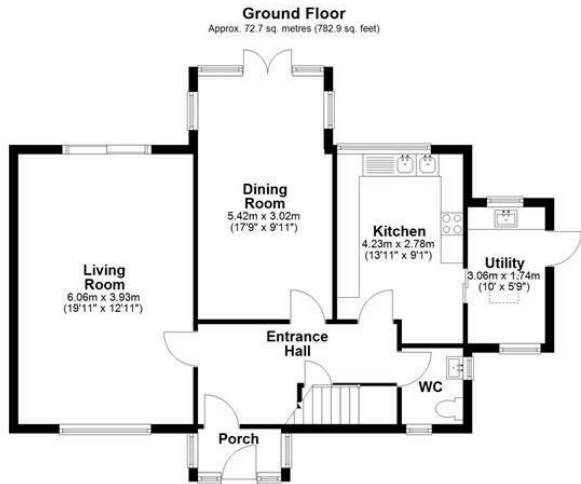
is also ladder access to the large loft room, which has a roof light. The shower room has been refitted and includes a walk-in shower and WC.

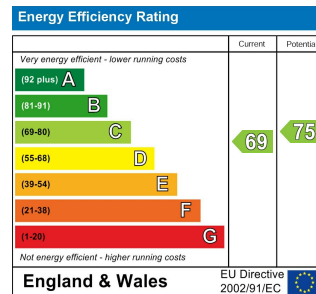
