



Alfred Heaver was an ambitious and successful local Victorian property developer who built over 4,000 homes across Wandsworth, Battersea and Fulham, and is well known for his work on the Heaver Estate in the late 1880's / early 1890's, which is now a conservation area between Tooting Common and Balham High Road.

Ritherdon Road was the first to be laid out in 1888 and was to be the main access to the estate.
