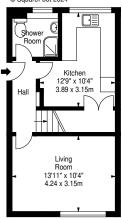

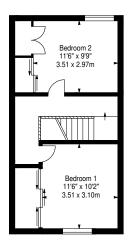

Location

Now a bustling town offering a wide range of amenities from boutique shops and cafes to banks and supermarkets. Musselburgh is a popular coastal town situated to the east of Edinburgh city centre. Public transport, by way of regular bus services from Bridge Street or trains from Musselburgh Train Station, make the 8-mile commute into Edinburgh Waverley an easy task on a daily basis. Schooling is well represented in both the public and private sector with Musselburgh Grammar being one of the oldest Grammar schools in Scotland. The property is also conveniently located for the Jewel & Esk Campus of Edinburgh College and the Queen Margaret University Campus.
