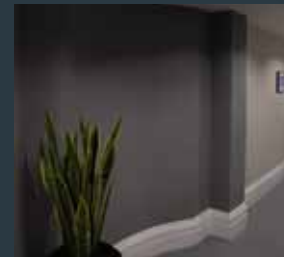

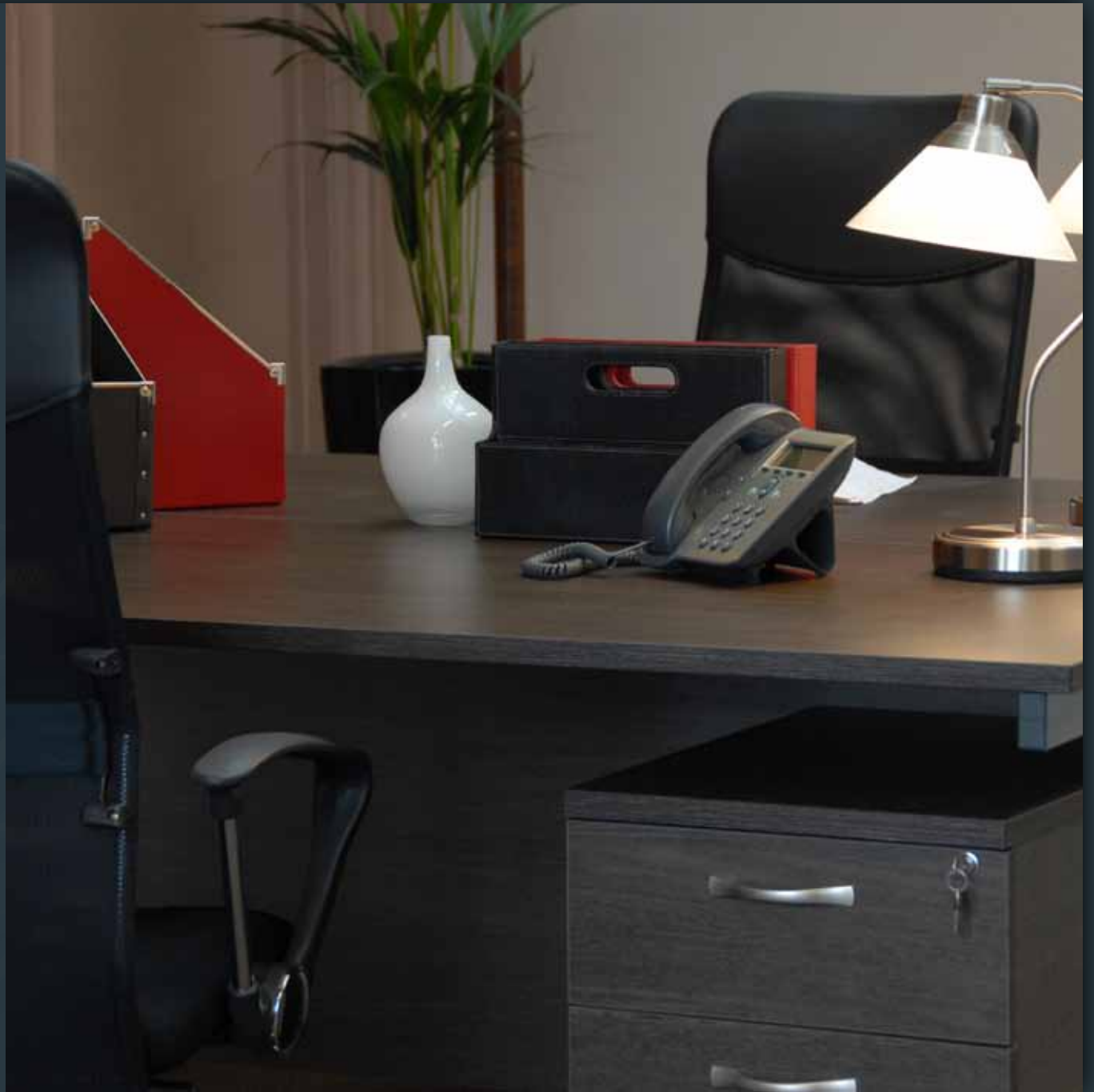

Whether it's dining out, visiting a theatre or calling into one of the many bars and clubs situated within the city centre, your options are almost limitless.

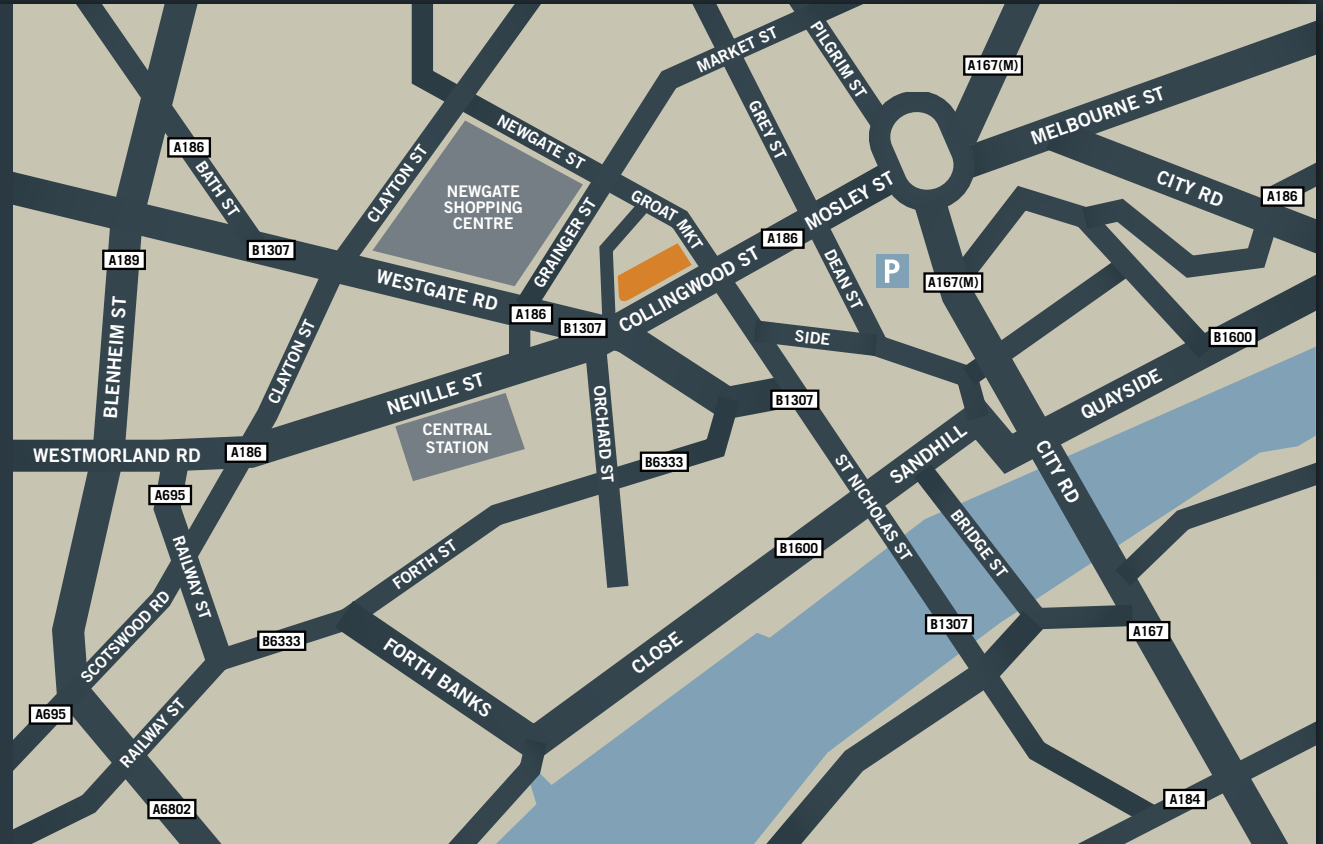




COLLINGWOOD BUILDINGS NEWCASTLE

PERFECTLY LOCATED

Located in the heart of the city centre, Collingwood Buildings forms part of the historic office core known as Grainger Town. The area over recent years has seen various initiatives aimed at regenerating this part of the city. The property is situated on the northern side of Collingwood Street and is approximately 200 metres to the east of the Central Railway and Metro Stations. Collingwood Street links with Mosley Street and the Central Motorway within approximately 400 metres to the east and Westgate Road and the Redheugh Bridge approximately ½ mile to the west. The latter provides direct access onto the A1(M) Western Bypass.
