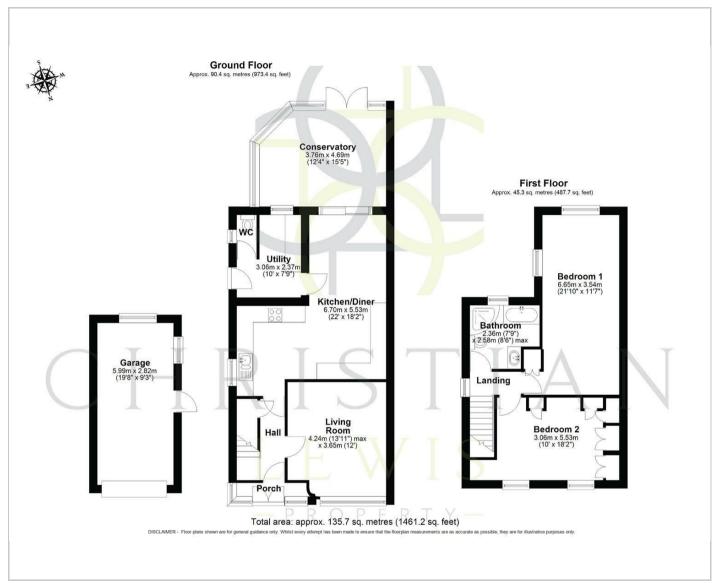

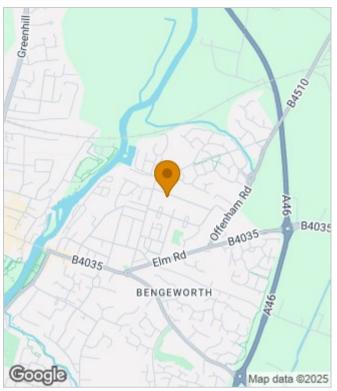




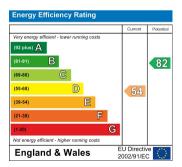


Floor Plans Area Map
