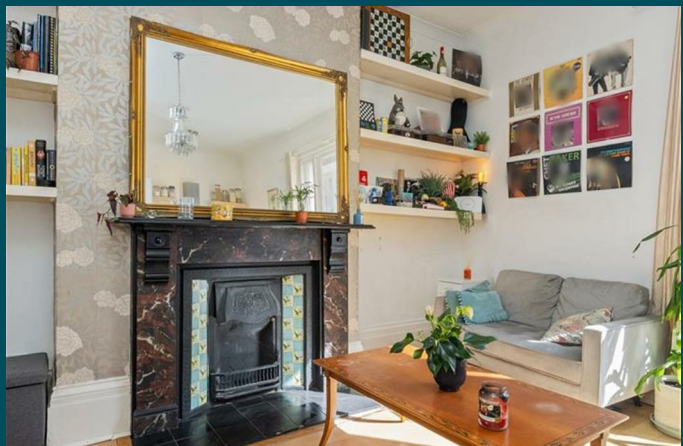




Flat 1, 31 Queens Road

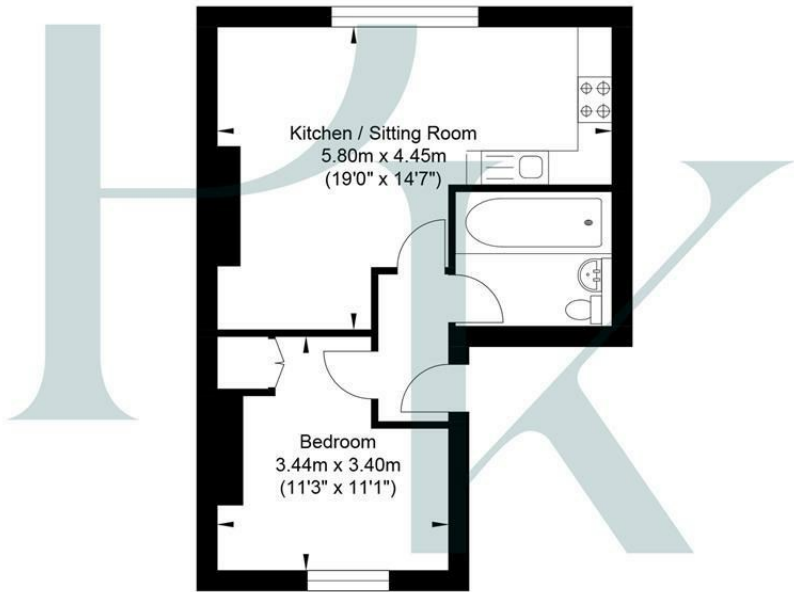
