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On the ground floor is a cloak room, a large open plan living and dining room with a large stone fireplace housing a wood burning stove. The kitchen is fully equipped with solid oak wood units, a range cooker, granite work tops and a breakfast bar. Doors on all sides lead out to the wonderful landscaped garden.

The oak staircase is the original main staircase of the Manor House and leads up past the full height Palladian window to the first floor where there are three good size bedrooms and a family bathroom. On the top floor is a further bright and spacious bedroom with an ensuite bathroom.

There is a large, mature landscaped garden to the rear, with a York stone patio and table, a greenhouse and a children's play area. In addition there is a studio with electricity, wi-fi and heating - ideal as an office or a gym. The property exudes character throughout with beautifully proportioned rooms and period features.
