To the rear is a 96 foot garden with a large brick built garage which could be converted to a home office or gym.

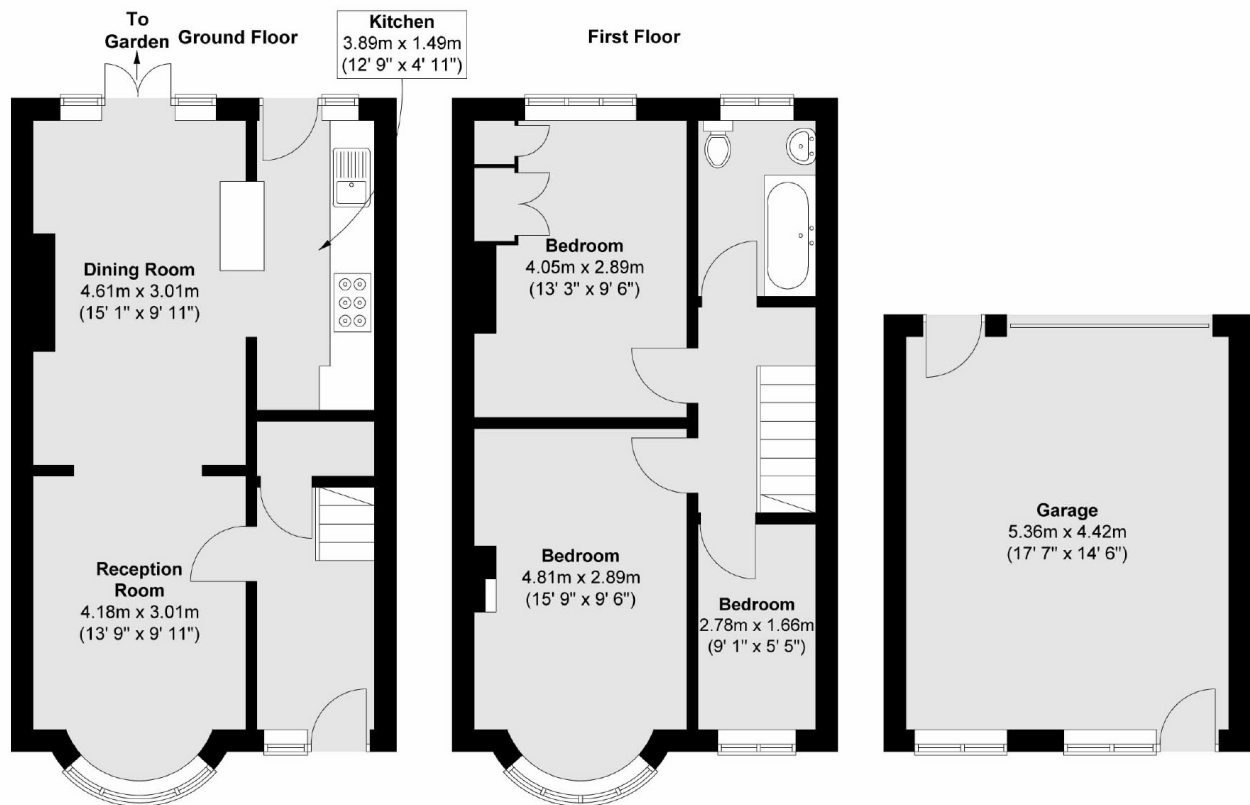
