A stunning, modern built family home set on the River Thames in the sought after village of Bray. Offering 135ft of river frontage with far reaching views, houses of this quality are rarely available.

Vicarage Drive is a stone's throw from the acclaimed "Fat Duck" and "Waterside Inn" of Bray Village.





Accommodation is made up of a large entrance hall with double height vaulted ceiling to galleried mezzanine. The full rear width of the house is designed to take in the river aspect and is made up of a stylish integrated kitchen open plan onto dining area, which leads onto a large living room. There is a further utility room.

On the ground floor there are two double bedrooms, one with en-suite and a guest W.C, and a large enclosed lift to the first floor. Upstairs the large landing opens onto an office space overlooking the river with retractable doors. The two principal suites have private river facing balconies with en-suite bathrooms. There are two further double bedrooms also with en-suite and views of St.Michael's Church Tower.

The house is accessed via electric gates from the privately owned road. There is a large single garage and workshop and parking for many cars. To the rear a mature, tiered garden includes a large entertaining terrace overlooking the river, boathouse/studio and large lawned area leading to 135ft of river frontage and moorings.
