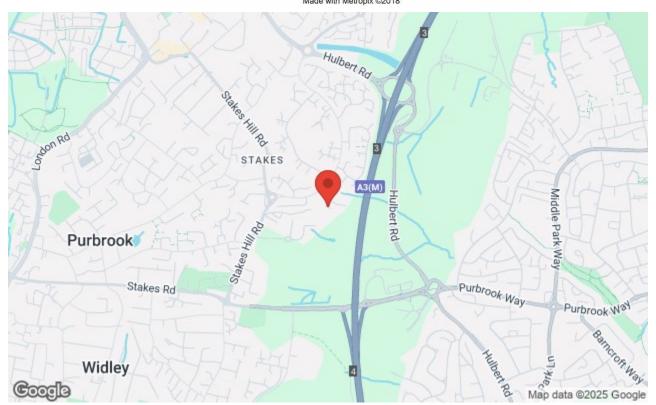

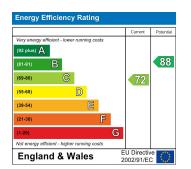

> For properties in England, the Tenant Fees Act 2019 means that in addition to rent, lettings agents can only charge tenants (or anyone acting on the tenant's behalf) the following permitted payments:

- Holding fee (a maximum of 1 week's
- · Deposits (a maximum deposit of 5 weeks' rent for annual rent below £50,000, or 6 weeks' rent for annual rental of £50,000 and above);
- · Payments to change a tenancy agreement eg. change of sharer (capped at £50 or, if higher, any reasonable costs);
- · Payments associated with early termination of a tenancy (capped at the landlord's loss or the agent's reasonably incurred costs);
- Where required, utilities (electricity, gas or other fuel, water, sewerage), communication services (telephone, internet, cable/satellite television), TV
- · Council tax (payable to the billing
- · Interest payments for the late payment of rent (up to 3% above Bank of England's annual percentage rate);
- · Reasonable costs for replacement of lost keys or other security devices;
