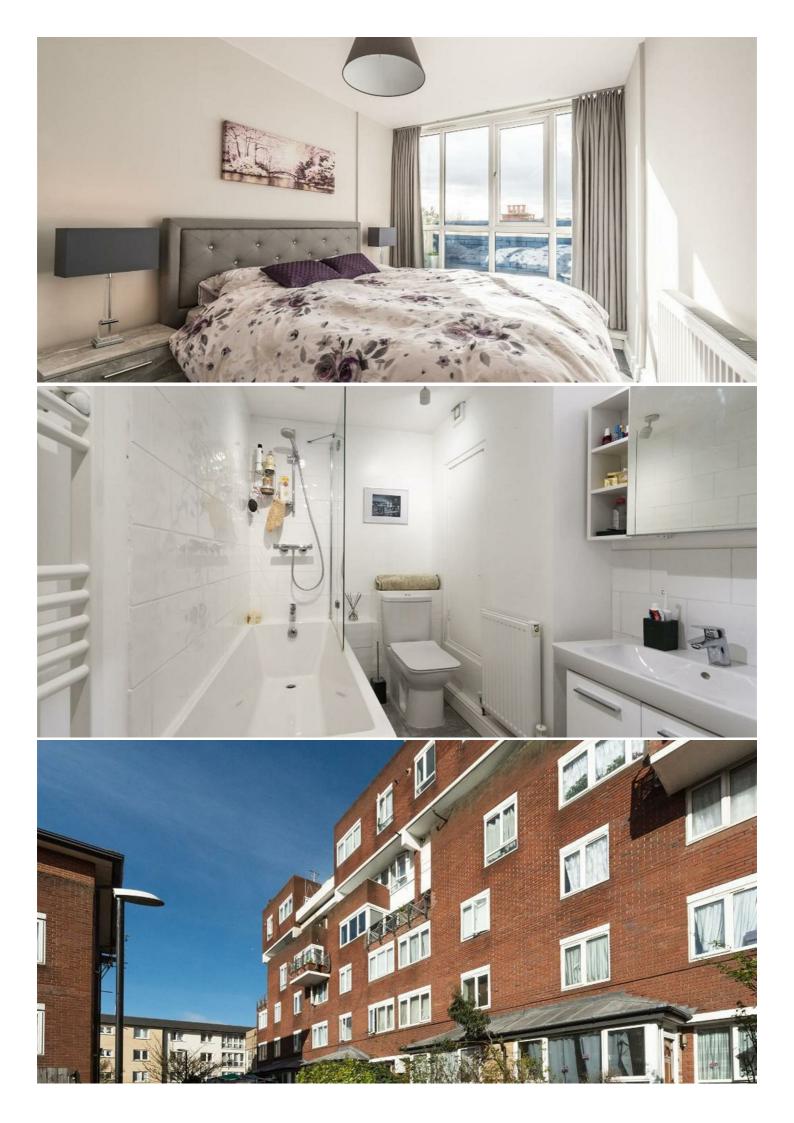

Area Map

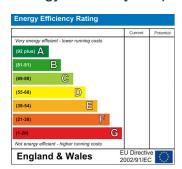




Floor Plan
