The property benefits from ample off road parking (driveway completed in January 2025), UPVC Soffits and Facias (2025) and an enclosed rear garden! The accommodation is supplemented by gas fired central heating, UPVC double glazing and briefly comprises:- entrance hallway, lounge, dining kitchen and side lobby with access to storage. To the first floor the landing provides access to two double bedrooms, bathroom and separate WC. Outside, there is off road parking for a number of vehicles to the front elevation and an enclosed rear garden. Chinley Road is well situated for Chaddesden and its range of shops, schools and transport links together with excellent road links for the A52, M1 motorway, A50 and Nottingham East Midlands Airport.





### **Rivers & Seas - Flood Risk**



This map shows the chance of flooding from rivers and / or the sea, taking into account flood defences and their condition.



#### Risk Rating: Very low

- **High Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 30 (3.3%) in any one year.




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### **Surface Water - Flood Risk**

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
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### **Surface Water - Climate Change**








### **Radon Gas**



#### What is Radon?

Radon is a natural radioactive gas, which enters buildings from the ground. Exposure to high concentrations increases the risk of lung cancer. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) recommends that radon levels should be reduced in homes where the annual average is at or above 200 becquerels per cubic metre (200 Bq/m3).








## Local Area Road Noise





This data indicates the level of noise according to the strategic noise mapping of road sources within areas with a population of at least 100,000 people (agglomerations) and along major traffic routes. This indicates a 24 hour annual average noise level with separate weightings for the evening and night periods.

Noise levels are modelled on a 10m grid at a receptor height of 4m above ground, polygons are then produced by merging neighbouring cells within the following noise classes:

- 75.0+ dB
- 70.0-74.9 dB
- 65.0-69.9 dB
- 60.0-64.9 dB
- 55.0-59.9 dB


