This beautifully presented three bedroom period home is set on a sought-after, tree-lined road within the popular Co-Op Estate. Thoughtfully refurbished while retaining charming original features such as the Art Deco picture window, it boasts a stylish new kitchen with quartz worktops and a Belfast sink, an upgraded boiler installed in February 2025, full rewire, wood burner with a quartz hearth, fresh plastering, and restored wooden flooring.

The welcoming entrance hall showcases a statement wooden staircase featuring stylish bannisters and spindles, leading into a bright and spacious lounge with bespoke fitted alcove units and large picture windows that fill the room with natural light. This inviting space flows into the open-plan kitchen and dining area, perfectly designed for modern living. Upstairs, a vaulted ceiling with skylight enhances the sense of space and brightness. There are three bedrooms, with the main bedroom featuring bespoke fitted wardrobes, alongside the family bathroom.

Outside, the landscaped rear garden provides a peaceful retreat with a new decked terrace, fresh fencing, and beautifully arranged planting including a fig tree, magnolia, winter-flowering cherry, herbs, ornamental grasses, and rows of lavender. The east/westerly aspect ensures the garden is a true sun trap, with sunlight from morning through to evening.


The location is ideal for families, with highly regarded schools nearby including the Ofsted Outstanding Alexander McLeod Primary School, just 0.2 miles away. Abbey Wood Station (0.5 miles) offers fast Elizabeth Line, Southeastern, and Thameslink connections with direct routes to Canary Wharf, Liverpool Street, and Heathrow. Excellent bus and road links provide easy access across London and beyond.

Nearby green spaces such as Lesnes Abbey Woods with its ancient woodland and historic ruins, Bostall Gardens, offering a playground, sports area, outdoor gym, and tennis courts provide plenty of leisure options.






