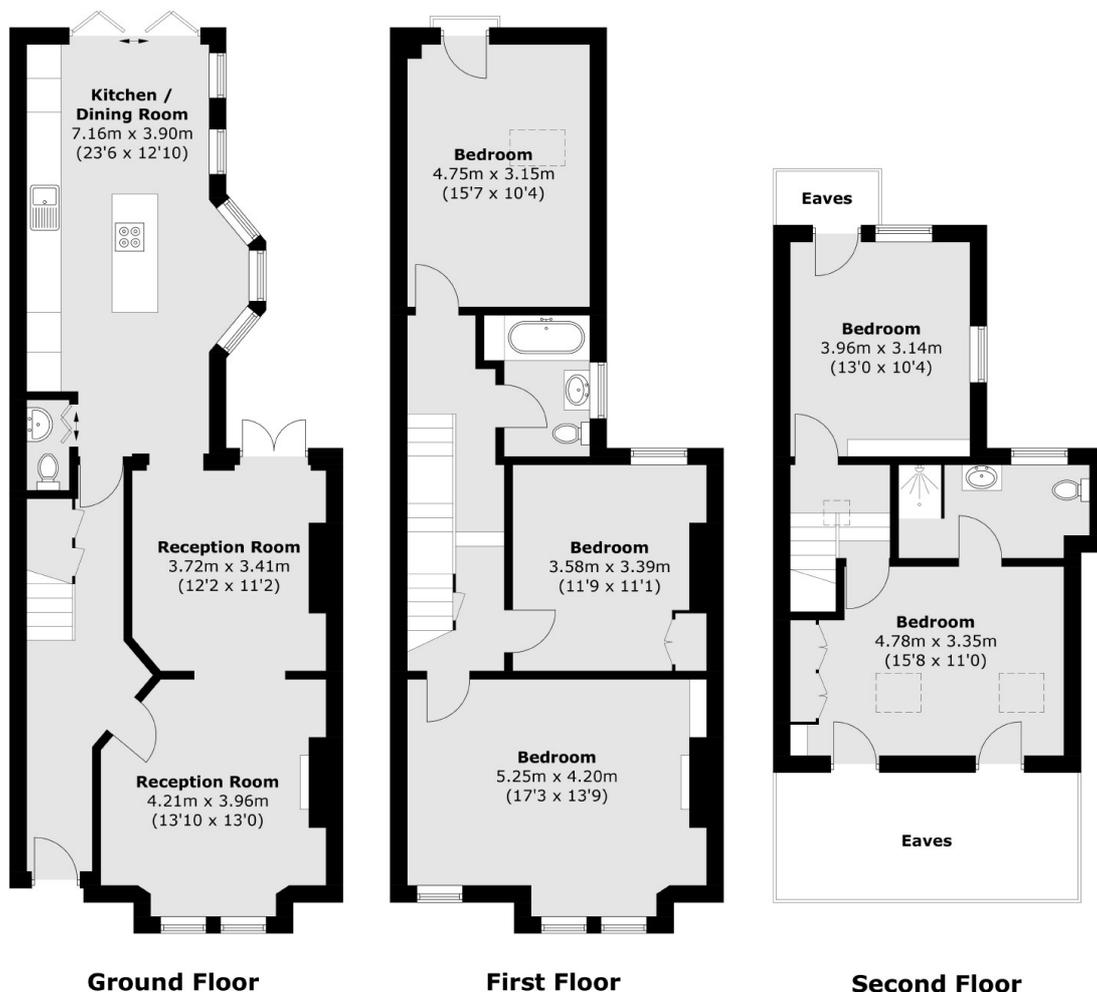
Once inside, the property has been thoughtfully designed with a lovely light and spacious stylishly designed kitchen. The kitchen itself is attractively fitted with smart shaker style units and built-in appliances whilst leaving plenty of space for a dining table. The Crittal windows add a very stylish modern twist to the overall design of the kitchen. The reception rooms have wooden polished floors and lovely original features including high ceilings, fireplaces, cornices, and original doors.

Upstairs the layout is again well thought out. On the first floor to the front is a very large double bedroom with a bay window and two further double bedrooms served by a modern family bathroom/WC. Two generous double rooms within the converted loft create a delightful principal suite with lovely views over the rear garden from a Juliet balcony and with a beautifully appointed shower room/WC. There is also generous loft storage.

The West facing garden is a delight; mainly lawned it receives wonderful natural light into the kitchen area. At the same time there is an excellent feeling of seclusion from the rear with an established tree providing a lovely natural screen.
