


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

A detached bungalow constructed by Pye Homes, set off the road and accessed down a footpath, with driveway parking in front of the original garage, which has now been converted to a home office with loft storage space.

The current sellers have carried out several improvements, including replacing the boiler, the bathroom, flooring and general redecoration and refurbishment.

Egremont Drive is on the established Lower Earley development, where there are local shops available at Maiden Place, with more extensive facilities at the Asda and Marks & Spencer complexes in Lower Earley. Maiden Erlegh Nature Reserve and Laurel Park are nearby.

Bus services in the area provide access into Reading town centre, where the main line railway station offers services to Paddington, on the Elizabeth Line, and also to Waterloo which run through the Earley and Winnersh Triangle railway stations.

The M4 motorway can be accessed either at Junction 11, where there is also the A33 south to Basingstoke, as well as Green Park and its new railway station; or at Junction 10 where London then lies approximately 40 miles away and Heathrow Airport approximately 28 miles away
