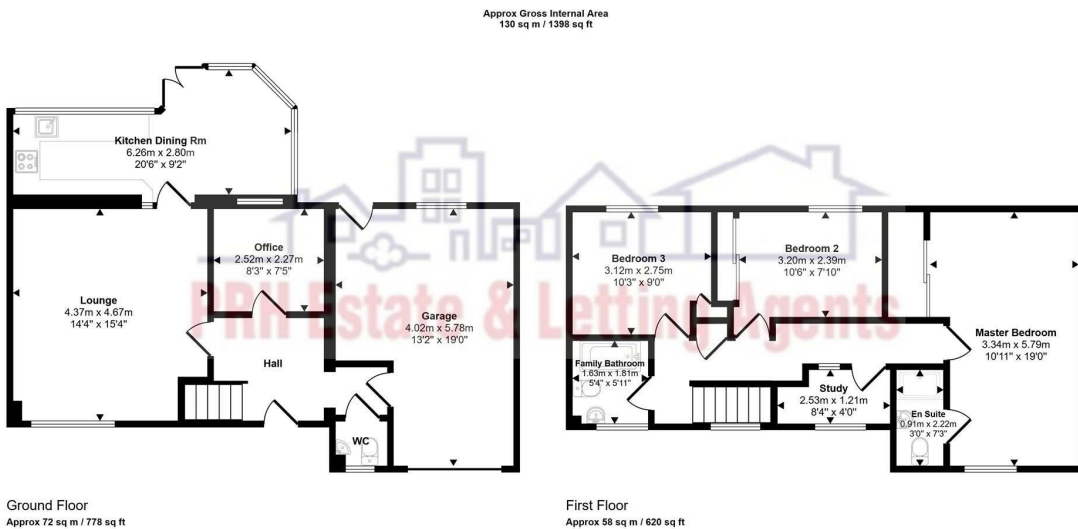

From Penzance proceed in a westerly direction on the A30 towards Landsend passing the villages of Buryas Bridge and Drift. Turn left onto the B3283 signposted St Buryan. Once in the village take the 4th turning on the left into Kew Pendra and then the second on the right where the property is situated on the right.
