From Penzance proceed across the promenade to Newlyn. After the bridge at the crossroads continue straight across onto Chywoone Hill. Just after Newlyn School of Art turn right into Tredavoe Lane taking the second right into Gloucester Crescent. The property is situated on the upper side of the green.
