# Step Inside

Set down a lane off Teign Street, beyond a metal gate, the front door leads in to the entrance hall of this cottage with stairs to the first floor opening through to the lounge/diner. The lounge area has a window to the front and the dining area has French doors to the rear courtyard. There is access from the dining room to two under stairs cupboards and there is an opening in to the kitchen.


The kitchen is at the rear with white base and wall units with a window and door to the rear courtyard. It has tiled splash backs, an electric cooker and space for a fridge/freezer and washing machine. The Worcester boiler is housed on the wall and there is a white single bowl single drainer sink unit.

The first floor landing has a window to the rear and doors to two bedrooms and the bathroom and the stairs lead on to the master bedroom on the top level.

There is one first floor bedroom to the front and another to the rear. The bathroom has a white suite with a 'P' shaped bath with shower over and shower screen and tiled surround. There is a low level flush WC and pedestal wash hand basin, ladder style heated towel rail and mirror fronted medicine cabinet and extractor fan.

The top bedroom has windows to the front and rear with open outlooks, built in wardrobe and cupboard into the eaves space. There is access to further eaves space on the landing outside.

The house has gas central heating and double glazing.

# Step Outside

At the front, an iron gate gives access off Teign Street down a short lane to the cottage. The cottage is therefore tucked away, yet it is just off the bustle and buzz of Teign Street with its small shops, restaurants and cafes.

At the rear, there is a walled courtyard with room for table and chairs which gets the sun from May to September from about 10am until about 3pm - (when sunny!)









#### Sellers Insight




#### Location:
