Location

This property is located on one of the most soughtafter roads in Tunbridge Wells, featuring wide, treelined streets with minimal traffic. The mainline station is a 20-minute walk from the property, offering regular services to London Bridge and London Charing Cross, both reachable in under an hour.

Description

This stunning property is part of a beautiful Victorian conversion and features a grand entrance from the car park. Upon entering the top floor, you are welcomed by a spacious hallway equipped with an entry phone system and a large storage cupboard.

The accommodation includes a well-sized kitchen with fitted units and appliances, a large living room with front views, and three large double bedrooms with rear views offering stunning scenery. The family bathroom is spacious and modern, with a white suite that includes a bath with an overhead shower, a hand basin, and a toilet.

Externally, the property offers one allocated parking space in the front car park, along with ample unrestricted on-road parking. There is a communal garden to the rear.










Council Tax Band: D
