### The Property

This three bedroom semi enjoys a picturesque quiet Eden Valley village location, with spectacular open views to Blencarn Lake and the north Pennines. With the benefit of planning permission for a stylish ground floor extension, and the options available for refurbishment, it presents a rare opportunity to create a country home to your own taste and style. There is a local occupancy restriction which ensures a strong sense of community.

The ground floor comprises an entrance hall, living room and a dining kitchen along with inner hall, two store rooms and a WC all with scope for improvement. Upstairs three bedrooms and a shower room offer ample space for family living.

Outside, within a good sized plot, you find gardens on three sides of the property, with the rear offering the breathtaking views. Overlooking a verdant landscape, this vantage point offers a sense of peace and tranquility that is rare to find.

Imagine waking up to the sight of Blencarn Lake, rolling hills and lush greenery every morning or enjoy a quiet evening while watching the sun set.

### Location

Blencarn is a delightful village nestled in the heart of the Eden Valley, Cumbria, offering a peaceful rural lifestyle surrounded by breathtaking natural beauty. Positioned approximately 9 miles east of Penrith, 7 miles north of Appleby-in-Westmorland and just 12 miles from the Lake District National Park, it enjoys a superb location at the foot of the Pennines with far-reaching countryside views. The village is framed by rolling hills and lush green fields, with the serene Blencarn Lake nearby which is a favourite spot for fly fishing. Rich in history, Blencarn dates back to Roman times, with local landmarks nearby such as the "Hanging Walls of Mark Antony" bearing testament to its ancient past. The traditional village green and collection of characterful properties enhance its quintessential charm, while the village hall provides a focal point for community life. For lovers of the outdoors, the area offers immediate access to scenic walking routes including Cross Fell and the Pennine Way, with tranquil streams and the nearby national park adding to the village's appeal. Blencarn is an idyllic setting for those seeking a slower pace of life amid natural and historic scenery.

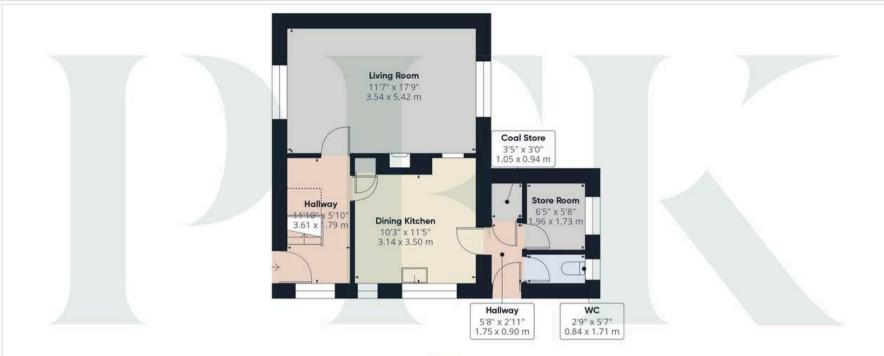
