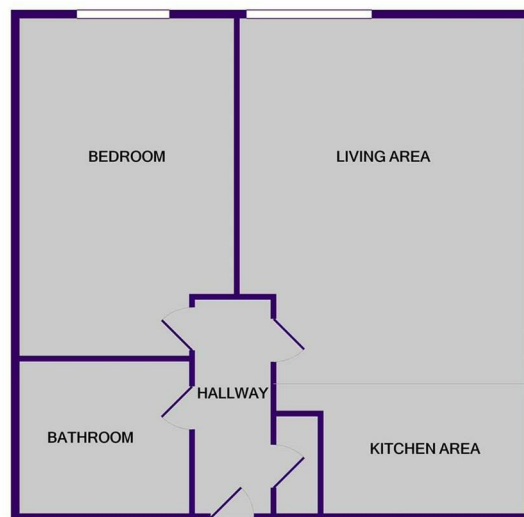

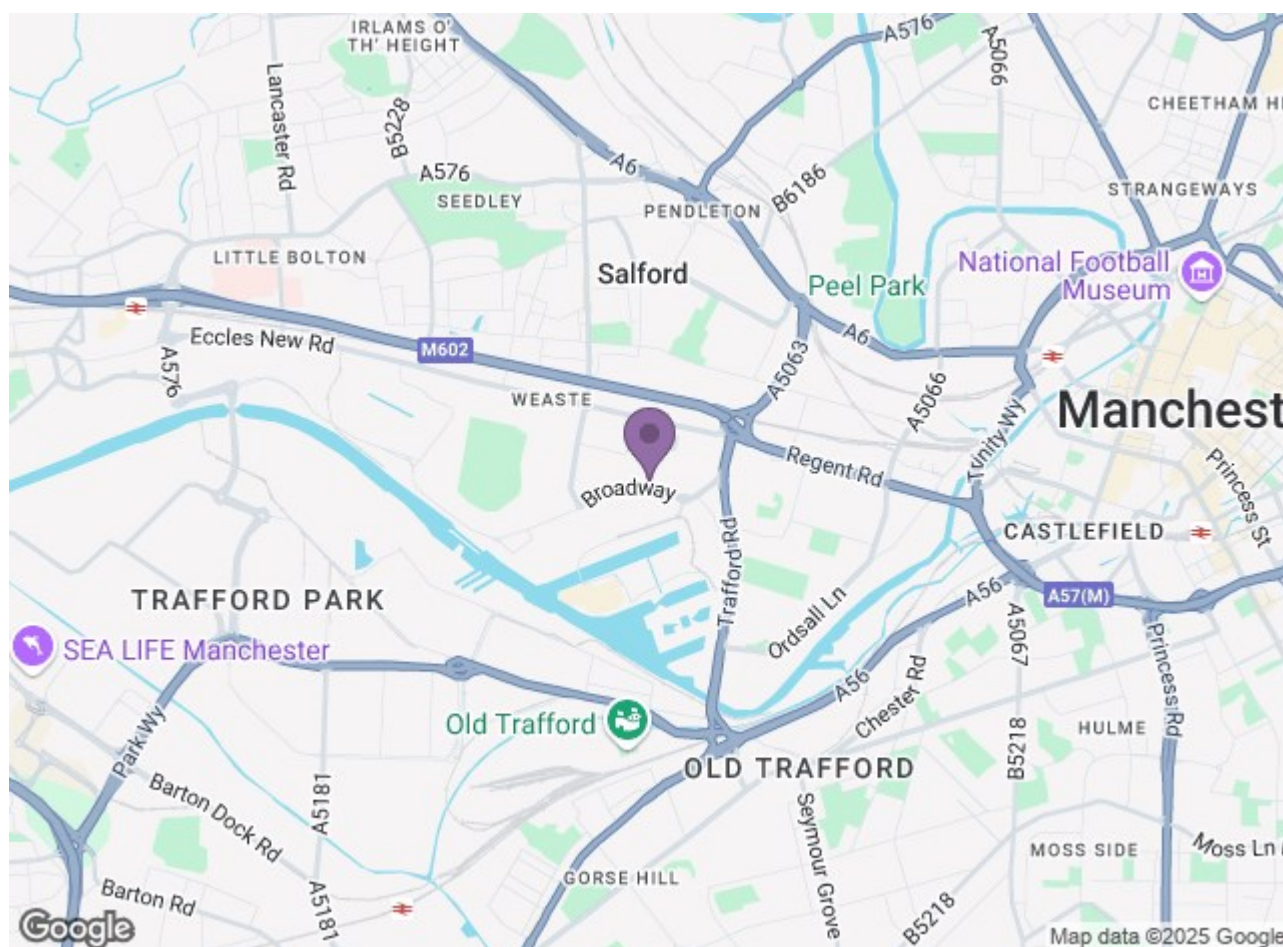
THE WINDOWS IN THIS DEVELOPMENT DO NOT OPEN - this is due to the close proximity of a neighboring saw mill and timber yard.
