Location

This handsome residence is found in the popular, rural hamlet of Aston, just outside the lovely village of Woore which is situated on the boundaries of Shropshire, Cheshire and Staffordshire. Aston has a thriving community with a Village Hall and Woore boasts a primary school, two pubs, a general store with Post Office and a locally renowned bakery. The nearby market towns of Market Drayton and Nantwich offer a wider variety of facilities along with Stoke on Trent and The Potteries.

The House

Aston Manor is an elegant and impressive Georgian Gentleman's residence with eight bedrooms and outbuildings. The interior is filled with original period features including coving, cornicing and open fireplaces. The kitchen/family area is a particular delight measuring over 36ft and is complete with Aga, large island, fitted appliances and full height doors overlooking the entertaining terrace and gardens.

Both the charming sitting room and delightful music room have doors opening onto the garden. The office on the ground floor is currently used as a bedroom and is complemented by a downstairs shower room and separate WC. There is also a versatile cellar.

The first floor comprises four well-proportioned bedrooms and a bathroom. One of the bedrooms could be used as a self-contained annexe as it has a stairwell with external access from the side of the house. A further four bedrooms, one of which is ensuite, are found on the second floor.

The Buildings

The rear courtyard is home to a selection of small brick buildings which are currently used as a gym and for storage but could easily be converted to a home office subject to any necessary planning consent.

The Gardens

Found to the front of the house, the lovely gardens are mainly laid to lawn and feature a traditional Ha-Ha. A generous-sized gravelled terrace with ample seating provides the perfect spot for entertaining on a summer's evening and a sheltered area to the side of the house is ideal for a morning coffee. A timber garden room to the side of the lawn could be used as a home office, art studio or children's play house.
