"The quiet location, a little off the beaten track, is one of our favourite things about the property," say the current owners, "and is partly what led us here in the first place."

"Another attraction of the house was the opportunity to put our own stamp on it," the owners continue, "as we were the first owners. We were able to choose the finishing, for example the limed oak kitchen units and elegant, neutral bathroom suites. All of the rooms are bright, airy and spacious, so the house is fantastic for entertaining. There is plenty of space for our grandchildren to play when the family comes to stay." The main reception rooms are generous in proportions and each have a door leading directly onto the gorgeously landscaped garden and patio. "We will miss the light and airy feel of the large rooms. The house is very spacious and bright."

The property boasts flexible accommodation spread across the ground floor, with 4 double bedrooms, 2 of which with en suite, a large family bathroom, a cloakroom, 2 main reception rooms, a study, and a beautiful modern kitchen with additional breakfast room and separate utility. The second reception room, which is currently used as a formal dining room, and the study, could even be used as additional bedrooms if required. "We use the south east facing breakfast room all the time. It is just lovely with the sun streaming in all day."

The garden too is wonderful, facing south with a patio area which the owners use daily. "In the warmer months, we have breakfast in the garden every day," they say, "and often dine al fresco in the evenings too. We have put a lot of love and care into the garden during our 28 years here, and it is just lovely, mostly laid to lawn with pretty borders and larch and fir trees." "We hosted engagement parties for both of our children here, as well as our daughter and son-in-law's wedding reception with a marquee in the garden." There are also around 1.5 acres of paddocks with a stable/log shed, accessed separately via a five bar gate.

"Charing is a lovely, Olde Worlde little village, with a beautiful old church as well as all amenities including butcher's, newsagent, post office, grocery store and antique shops. We are also well located for transport links to London, as well as the Ashford International."\*


