The home is warmed by oil-fired central heating, with a solid fuel stove in the heart of the living room that's connected to the system, ideal for cosy winter evenings. Mains water and high-speed broadband are available, offering the best of both rustic retreat and modern convenience.

The setting is as practical as it is picturesque. Kilmeen National School is just 1km away, Clonakilty's lively shops, beaches and cafés are a mere 9km, Dunmanway is 12km, and Cork City and airport are just over 50km away, close enough for convenience, far enough for peace.


Whether you're looking for a country bolt-hole, a creative escape, or a charming full-time home with space to grow into, this little gem offers rare potential in an enviably scenic spot.
