Situated on the top floor of a traditional Victorian tenement, this is a particularly spacious one bedroom flat with far reaching views over the city, towards the Forth bridges and as far as Fife. The accommodation is extremely generous and is beautifully presented throughout.

There is a classic, bay windowed living room with an unobstructed view, ornate cornicing, fireplace and gas fire. The kitchen is fitted with modern white gloss units, breakfast bar, window seat, and recessed dining area. The design of the kitchen is both attractive and practical with a large pantry cupboard and utility area. With a bright south facing aspect, the double bedroom is very well-proportioned with ample room for furniture as well as having the benefit of a built-in cupboard. The room next door is currently set up as a luxurious dressing room but it would equally make an ideal study.

THE LOCAL AREA


