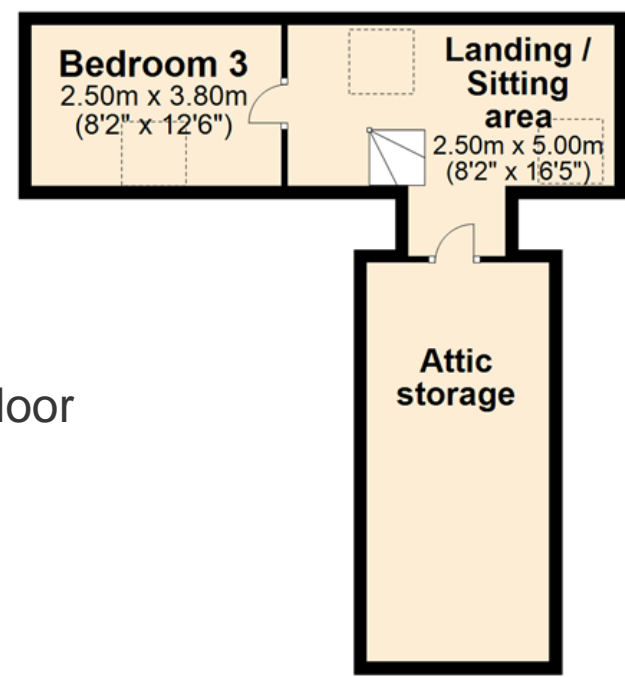
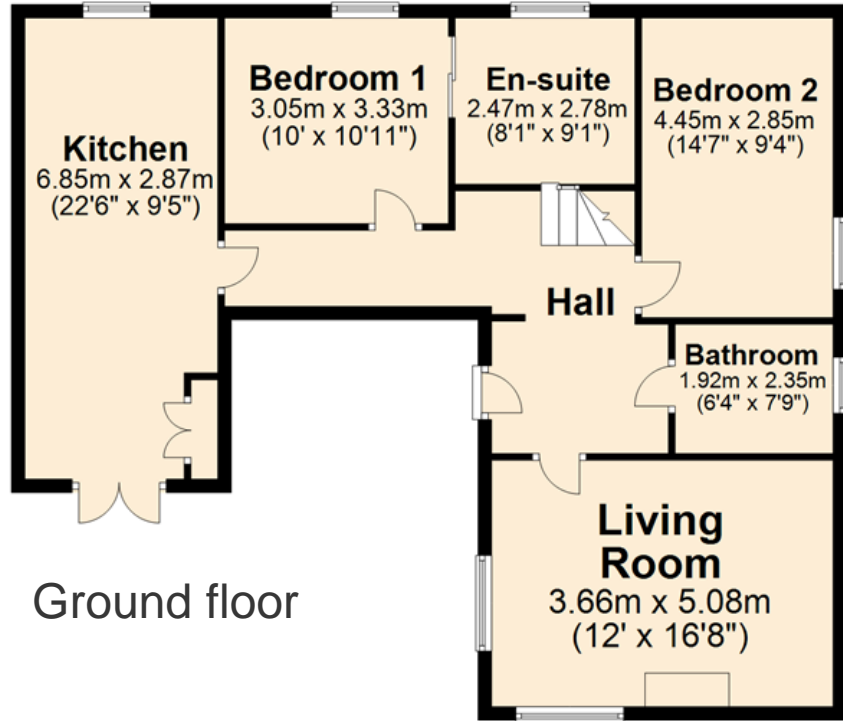

LOCATION

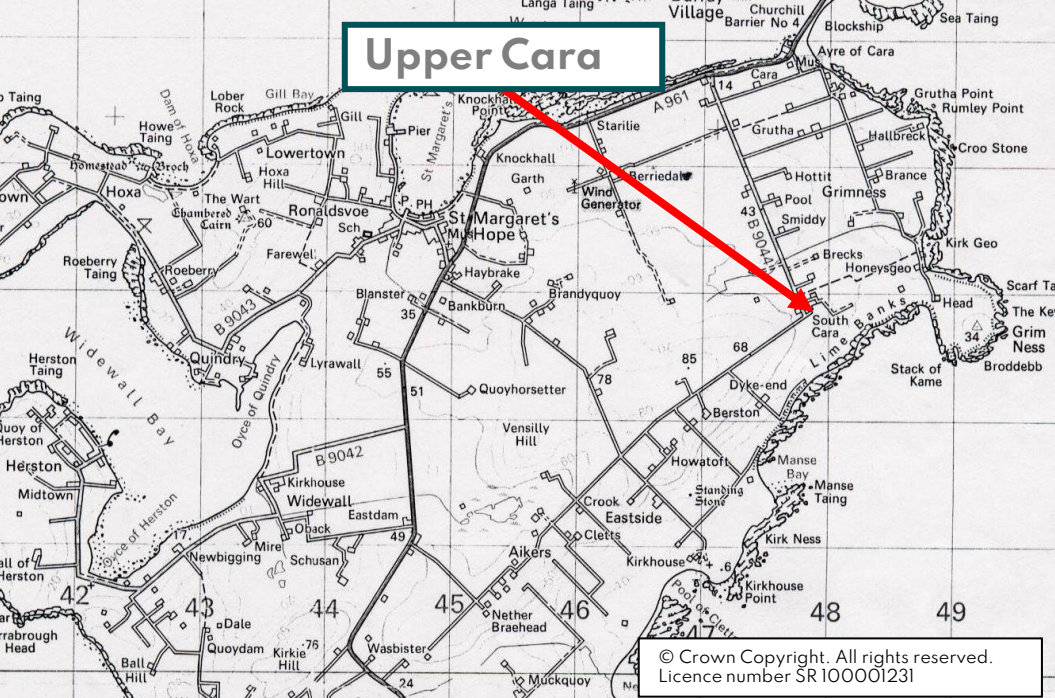
