The highest point locally is "Brayton Barff", standing 150 feet above sea level, it is popular with bird watchers, nature lovers and dog walkers alike, as is Selby Canal - Selby Canal is a quiet backwater from the Aire & Calder Navigation, providing a peaceful setting for boating, walking and cycling.

On Doncaster Road there are two pubs: The Grey Horse and Swan Inn for food and drink.

SHOPPING

The village is serviced by a Tesco Express and the fabulous Dawson Butchers - arguably the best meat and pies around. There is also a post office and Barnardo's Charity Shop on the A19 bypass that runs through Brayton.

In 2000, Brayton Community Centre replaced the old village hall and has a number of groups and facilities for everyone to enjoy, while the highly regarded Selby Golf Club (founded in 1907) is a beautiful par 71 course, built on sand-based; well drained land, making the course playable all year round.

From Pre School to High School, Brayton offers education and toddler groups for all ages from 0 - 16 years


Equestrian Enthusiasts:


Area Map
