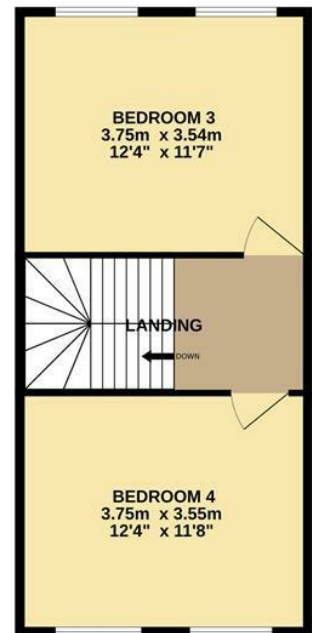
GROUND FLOOR
