Red Lodge has a range of shops and restaurants, health facilities, sports pavilion, a popular primary school and is well located for the A11/A14 providing access to Cambridge and Norwich.

Accommodation includes a living room/diner, fitted kitchen, three bedrooms and a bathroom. Externally, a walled garden and patio at the rear with a garage and additional parking for 3/4cars. There's also a small enclosed front garden.

Entrance Hall

With glazed double doors to the living/dining room. Stairs leading to the landing. Radiator.

Living/Dining Room

Spacious, well presented living/dining room with LVT wood flooring. Dual aspect windows. Electric heaters. Door leading to the kitchen. Glazed double doors leading to the entrance hall.

Kitchen

Modern range of eye and base level cupboards with worktop over. Stainless steel sink and drainer with mixer tap over. Integrated oven with inset hob and extractor above. Space and plumbing for washing machine. Attractively tiled splashbacks. LVT wood flooring. Window to the rear aspect. Half glazed door leading to the rear garden. Door to the living/dining room.

With doors leading to all bedrooms and bathroom. Airing cupboard. Stairs leading to the entrance hall.

Double bedroom with LVT wood flooring. Window to the rear aspect. Electric heater. Door to the landing.

Bedroom 2

11'1" x 8'10"

Double bedroom with LVT wood flooring. Window to the front aspect.

Electric heater. Door leading to the landing.

Bedroom 3

8'0" x 6'0"

Well proportioned bedroom with LVT wood flooring. Window to the front aspect. Electric heater. Door leading to the landing.

Bathroom

Contemporary white suite comprising low level, concealed cistern, W.C., inset handbasin with mixer tap over and built-in storage cabinet under and panelled bath with mixer tap and wall mounted shower over. Attractively tiled. Obscured window. Door leading to the landing.

Garage

With up and over door leading to the driveway.

Outside - Front

Hardstanding drive way, providing off road parking leading to the garage. Access gate to the rear garden. Lawned side area to the front.

Outside - Rear

Block paved patio area to the rear of the house with door leading to the kitchen. Lawned area with a variety of planted beds to the borders and a charming magnolia tree. Attractive pergola with a climber woven through. Access gate to the front.

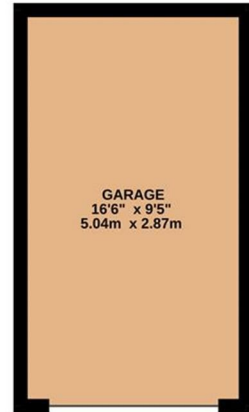
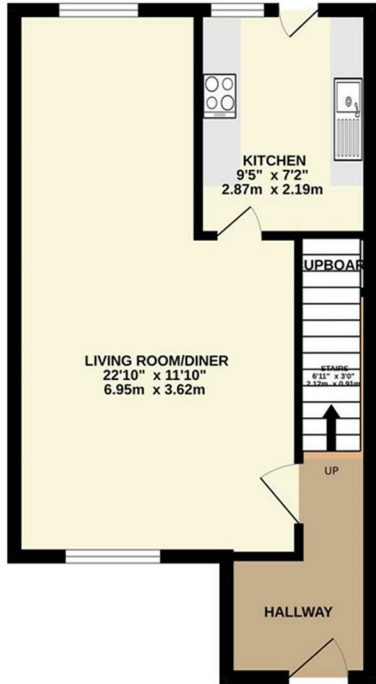

Location

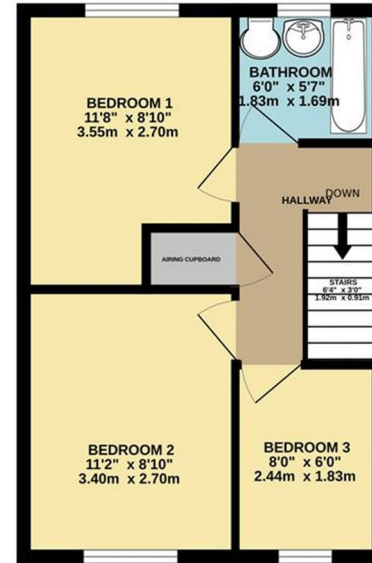

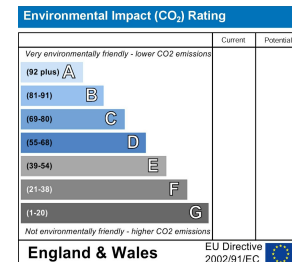
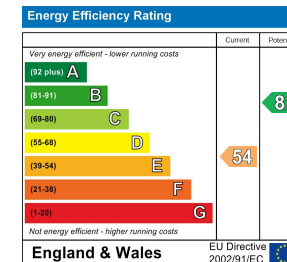
