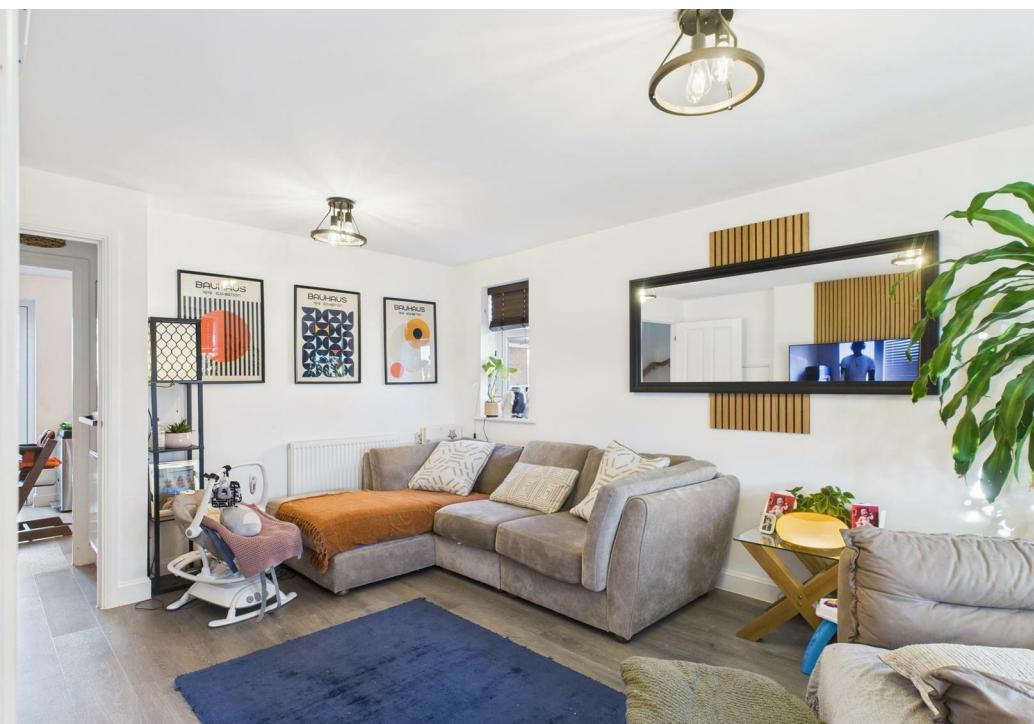


Nuthatch Lane, Peacehaven, BN10 8GY

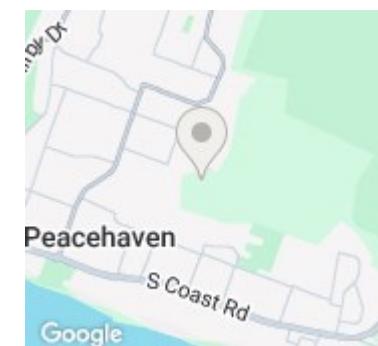
