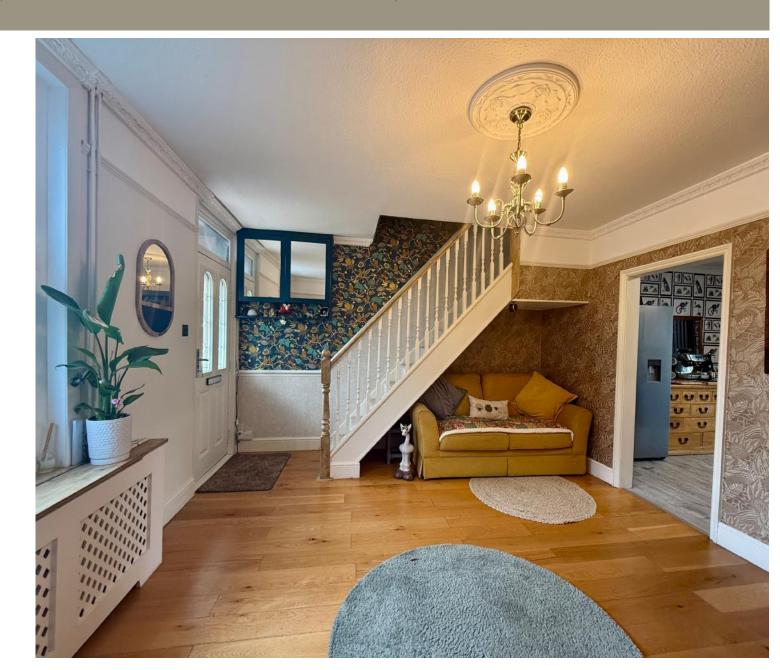
A charming Victorian terrace with stunning garden, driveway, and a showstopping studio in the heart of the village.

Practicality is another big plus here, with gated side access through the archway (a rare find in a terrace) and a driveway for offstreet parking.

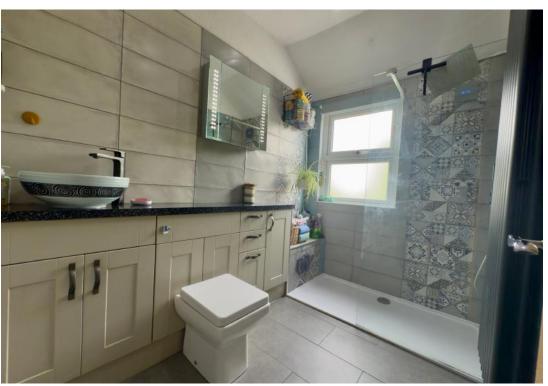

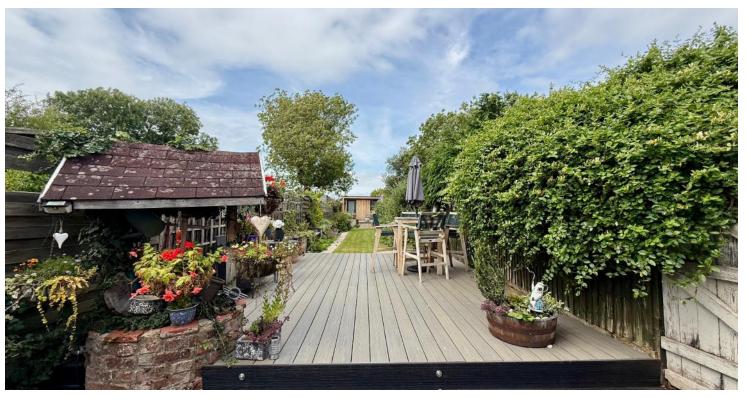
