From the first step inside, the house feels both welcoming and thoughtfully designed. The entrance hall provides useful storage and access to the principal ground floor rooms. To the front, the kitchen and dining space has been fitted with bespoke cabinetry and high-quality appliances from Bosch and Neff, including double ovens and an integrated fridge freezer. With its modern layout and careful detailing, it is a room that works as well for everyday family meals as it does for relaxed entertaining.

To the rear, the living room enjoys French doors opening directly onto the garden, creating a seamless link between indoors and out. A cloakroom completes the ground floor, adding everyday practicality.

The first floor is home to two generous bedrooms and a well-fitted family bathroom, while a further staircase leads to the top floor. Here, the principal suite benefits from fitted wardrobe space, eaves storage and a contemporary en suite shower room, creating a private retreat. A fourth bedroom adds flexibility, ideal as a study, nursery or guest accommodation.

The garden is a particular highlight. Secluded and not overlooked, it is framed by mature oak trees which lend both privacy and character to the space. A paved terrace creates the perfect setting for summer dining, with a neat lawn providing further versatility. The driveway at the front ensures convenient off-street parking.
